

- (b) Extend the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool to include: Township 29 North, Range 6 Yest, NMPM, All Sections 5 thra 8, incl., all Sections 17 and 18; Township 29 North, Range 8 Yest, NMPM, All Sections 1 through 5, incl., All Sections 8 through 17, incl.; Township 32 North, Range 11 Yest, NMPM, All Sections 13, 14, 23 and 26 and such other lands contiguous to said pool as may properly be included therein as supported by proper testimony and recommendations adduced at said hearing.
- (c) Extend the Dogie Canyon-Pictured Cliffs Pool to include: Township 26 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, All Section 15, N/2 Section 22 and such other lands contiguous to said pool as may properly be included therein as supported by preper testimony and recommendations adduced at said hearing.
- (d) Extend the West Kntz-Pictured Cliffs Pool to include: Township 26 North, Range 10 West, NAPM, W/2 Section 4, All Section 8 and such other lands contiguous to said pool as may properly be included the rein as supported by proper testimony and recommendations adduced at said hearing.
