TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST,
NMPM, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on March 17, 1953, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this 31st day of *MARCH*, 1953, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the records and the testimony adduced, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of the case and the persons and subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant's State 'P', Well No. 2, SW/4 SW/4 Section 29, Township 19 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, was completed in July 1936 as an oil well producing from the Grayburg formation of the Eunice-Monument Pool in the open-hole interval 3805-3935, having drilled through the Seven Rivers-Queen formation of the Eumont Gas Pool at an approximate depth of 3250-3580.

(3) That although recent experiments tend to show that mechanical packers and other devices are ordinarily available for successful dual/multiple completions of oil - gas wells, the Commission is unconvinced of the soundness as a waste-prevention practice, of such dual/multiple completions as a general practice in New Mexico without specific controls over each such project.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Amerada Petroleum Corporation, be, and it hereby is authorized to dually complete and produce its State 'P', Well No. 2, SW/4 SW/4 Section 29, Township 19 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, in such a manner that gas from the Seven Rivers-Queen formation of the Eumont Gas Pool may be produced through the annular space between the casing and the tubing, and oil from the Grayburg formation of the Eunice-Monument Pool through the tubing by proper perforations and the installation of a proper packer;

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, That upon the actual dual completion of such subject well applicant shall submit to the District Office of the Commission in which the subject well is located Form C-103, Form C-104, Form C-110 and Form C-122 outlining the information required on these forms by existing Rules and Regulations.

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, That subject well shall be completed, and thereafter produced, in such a manner that there will be no commingling within the well bore, either within or outside the casing of gas, oil and gas, or oil produced from either or both of the separate strata, and,

PROVIDED FURTHER, That said subject well for dual completion and production shall be equipped in such a way that reservoir pressures may be determined separately for each of the two specified strata, and further, be equipped with all necessary connections required to permit recording meters to be installed and used, at any time, as may be required by the Commission or its representatives, in order that natural gas, oil or oil and gas from each separate stratum may be accurately measured and the gas-oil ratio thereof determined, and,

PROVIDED FURTHER, That the operator applicant shall make any and all tests, including segregation tests, but not excluding other tests and/or determinations at any convenient time and in such manner as deemed necessary by the Commission; the original and all subsequent tests shall be witnessed by representatives of the Commission and by representatives of offset operators, if any there be, at their election, and the results of each test properly attested to by the applicant herein and all witnesses, and shall be filed with the Commission within ten (10) days after the completion of such test, and,

PROVIDED FURTHER, That upon the actual dual completion of such subject well, applicant shall submit to the Commission a diagrammatic sketch of the mechanical installation which was actually used to complete and produce the seal between the strata, and a special report of production, gas/oil ratio and reservoir pressure determination of each producing zone or stratum immediately following completion.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order after proper notice and hearing, the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-zone production in the interests of conservation.

Gentlemen:

By this letter of application the Amerada Petroleum Corporation wishes to state the following:

(a) That Amerada Petroleum Corporation State "P" No. 2 located in SW/4 of SW/4, Section 29, Twp. 19-S, Rge. 37-E, Lea county, was completed July 10, 1936 at a total depth of 3935 feet. The attached Exhibit A shows the location of this and other wells on the Amerada State "P" Lease together with the locations of all offset wells.

(b) That the subject well has 6 5/8 inch casing set at 3805 feet and cemented with 100 sacks of cement. The well is an oil well producing from the interval from 3805 to 3935 feet in the Grayburg formation.

(c) That the applicant proposes to dually complete the well to produce oil from the Grayburg and gas from the Seven Rivers - Queen formation in the following manner:

- (1) Perforate the 6 5/8 inch casing within the approximate interval of 3250 to 3580 feet opposite the Seven Rivers - Queen formation.
- (2) Set a production type packer below these perforations at approximately 3590 feet to separate the two pay zones.
- (3) Produce the Grayburg oil through the tubing and the Seven Rivers - Queen gas through the tubing - casing annulus.

(d) That the granting of this application for permission to produce the well as a dual completion with gas from the Seven Rivers - Queen formation and oil from the Grayburg formation is in the interest of conservation and the protection of correlative rights.

(e) That the applicant will comply with all rules and regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to maintain separation of production from the two pay zones.

(f) That the manner and method of the proposed dual completion is mechanically feasible and practical.

Therefore, Amerada Petroleum Corporation requests that the Oil Conservation Commission set a certain day upon which this application may be heard and after said hearing to grant permission in order that the applicant may dually complete the subject well as proposed in this application.
