ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on August 20, 1953, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 17 day of September, 1953, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony adduced and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the respective boundaries of the Gladiola-Wolfcamp, Lazy 'J', Lovington-Abo, Lovington-Paddock, Square Lake, and Cooper-Jal oil pools should be extended to include in such pools the respectively described lands in accordance with the testimony adduced and recommendations made for each pool at the hearing.

(3) That the boundary of the Langlie-Mattix Oil Pool should be contracted to eliminate therefrom the W/2 E/2 Section 19, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, NMPM.

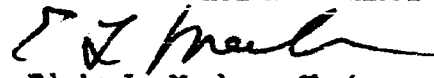

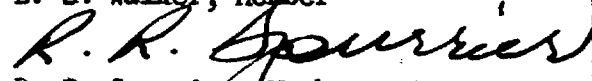

MR. WHITE: Without objection, it will be received.

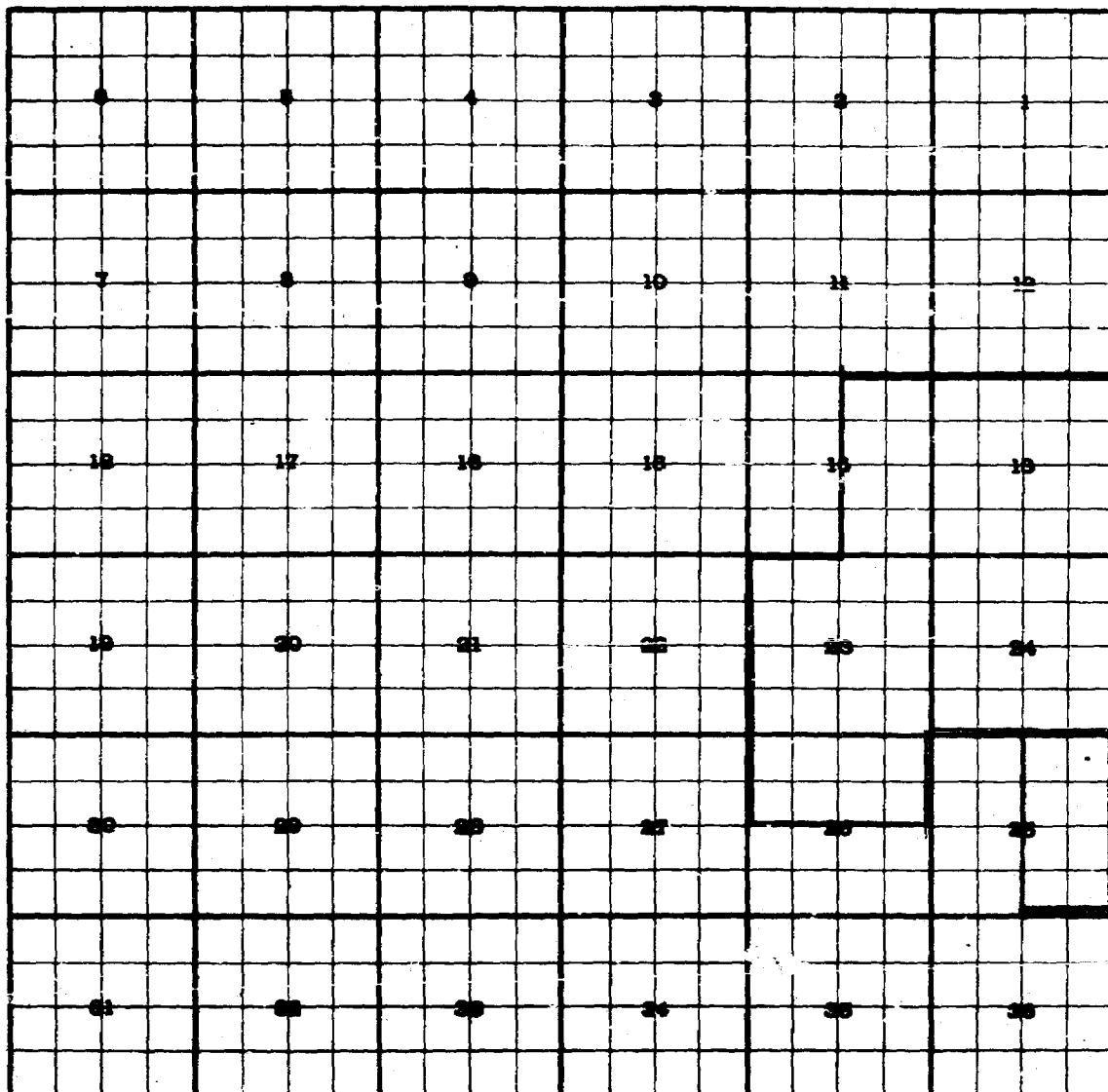

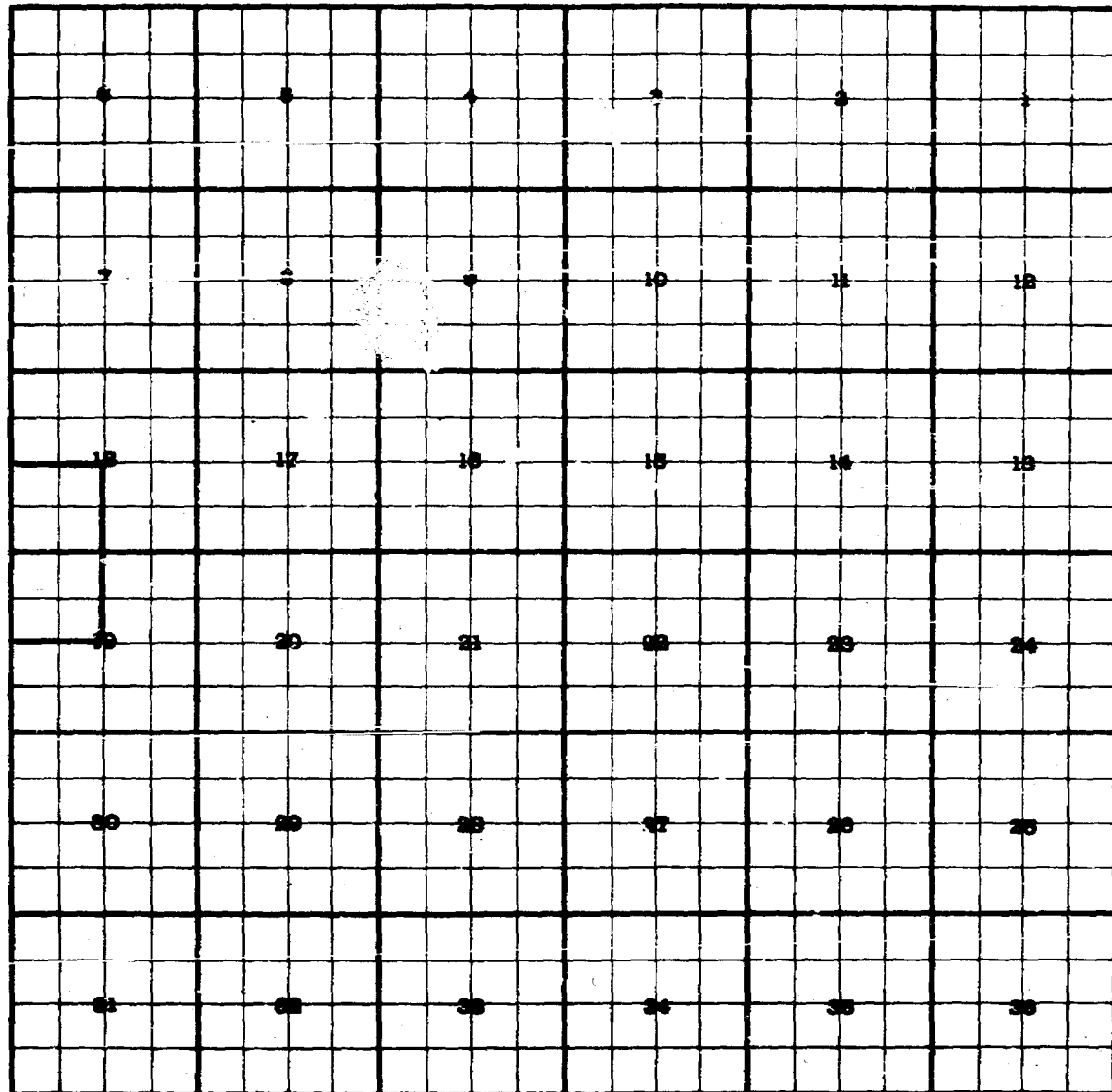

County Lea Pool Gladiola Wolfcamp

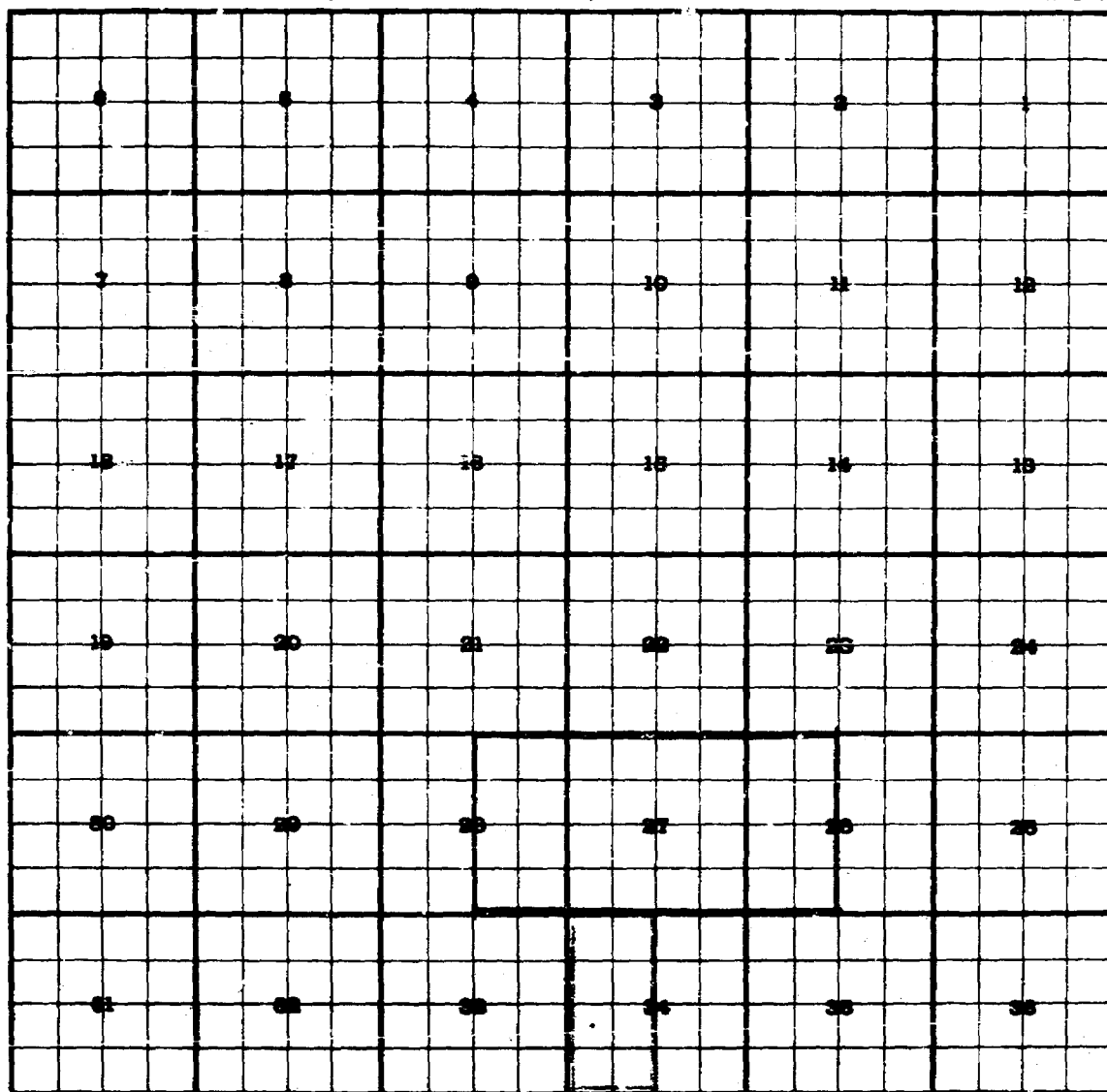
TOWNSHIP 12 South, RANGE 38 East, NEW MEXICO PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN

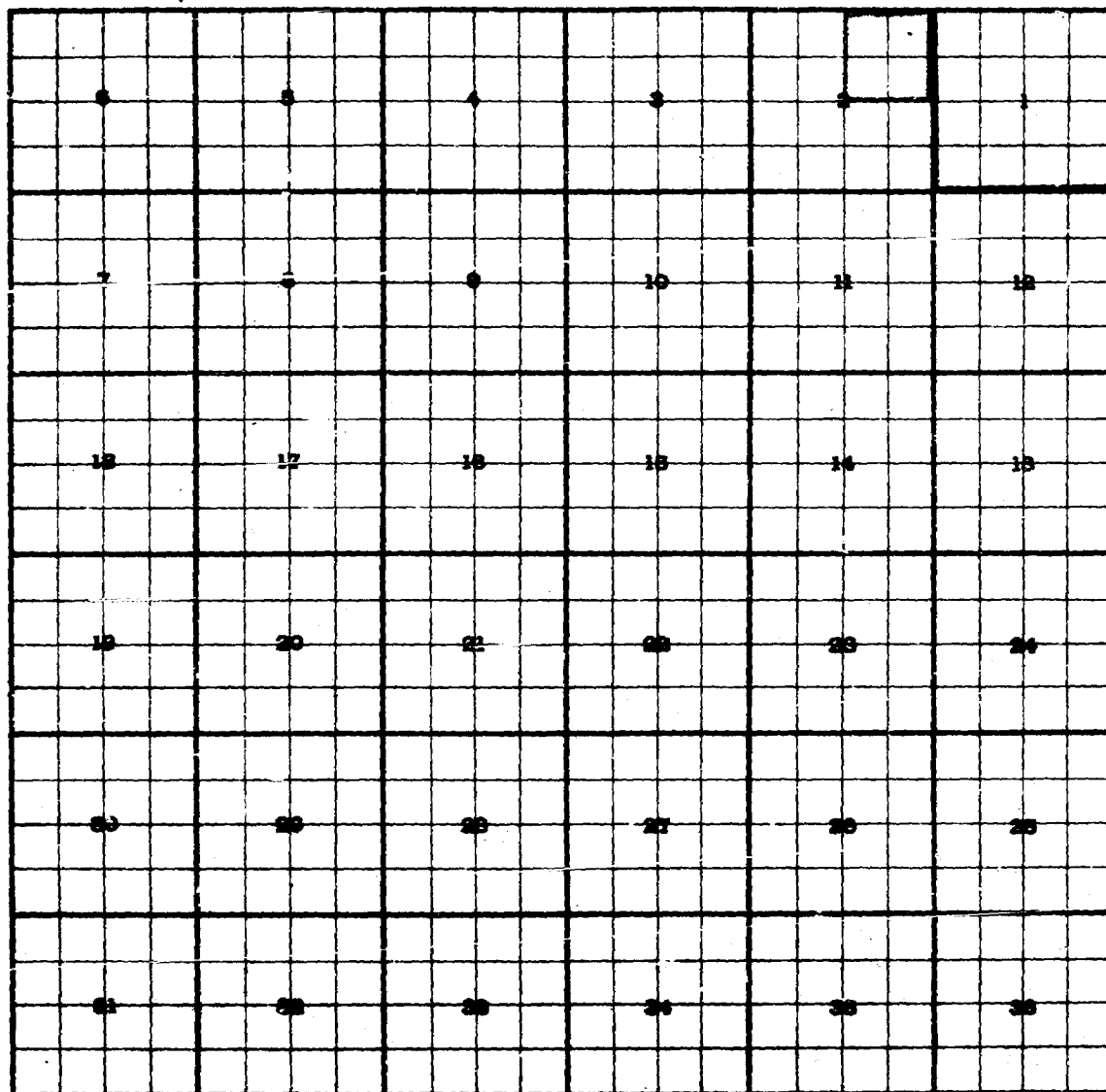

TOWNSHIP 17 South, RANGE 36 East, NEW MEXICO PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN



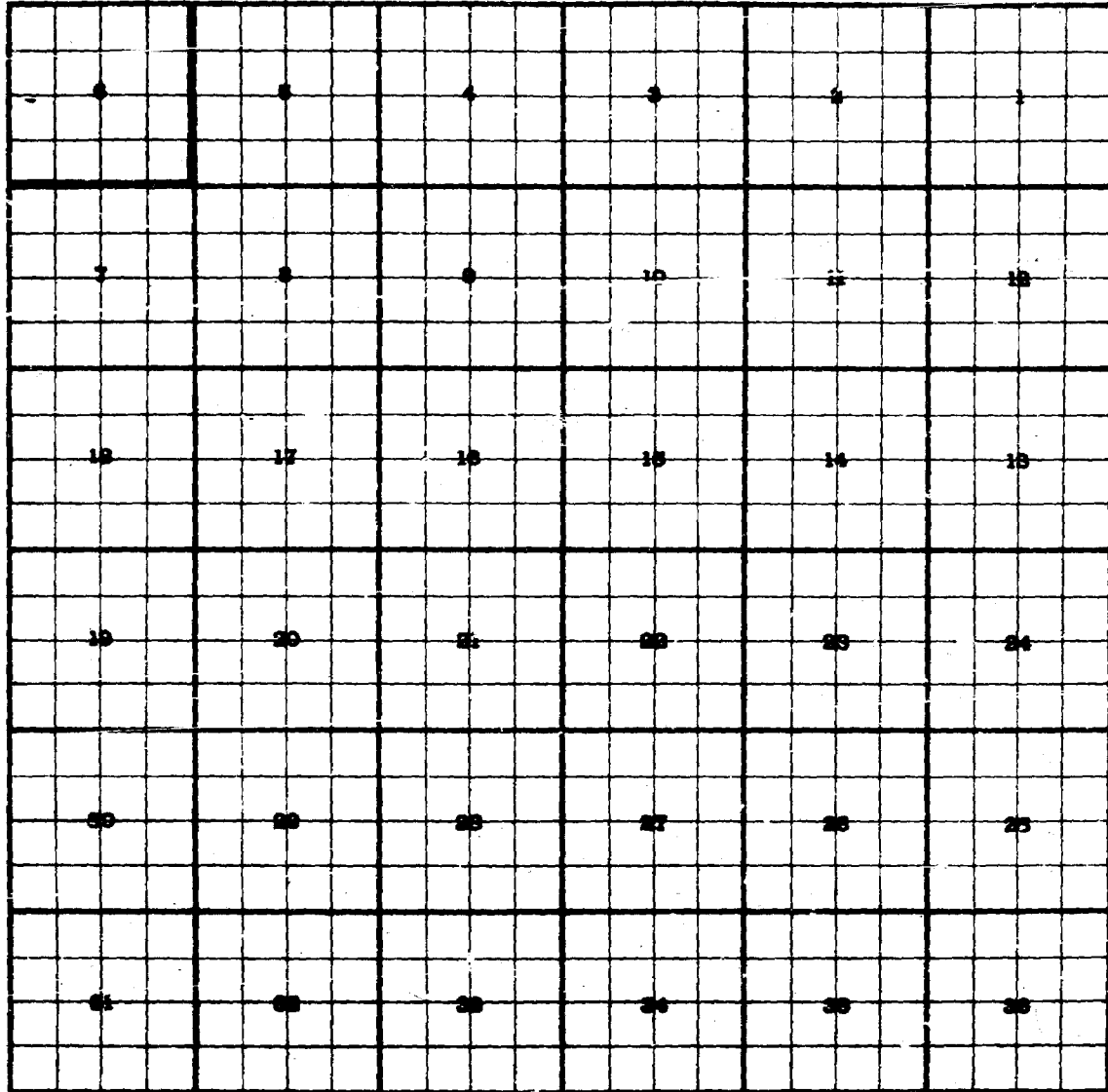

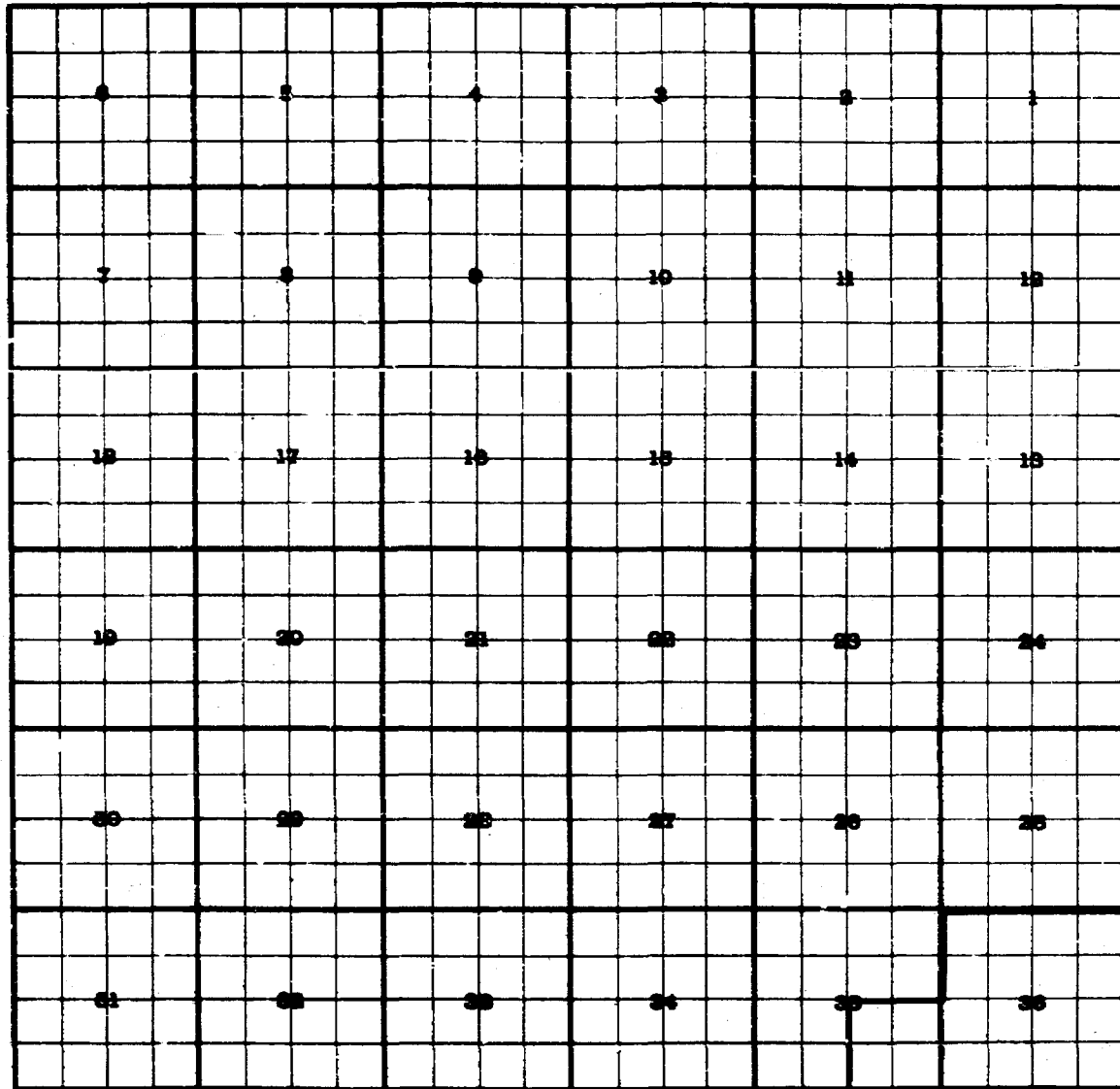
TOWNSHIP 17 South, RANGE 37 East, NEW MEXICO PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN

County Lea Pool Lorington - Aba

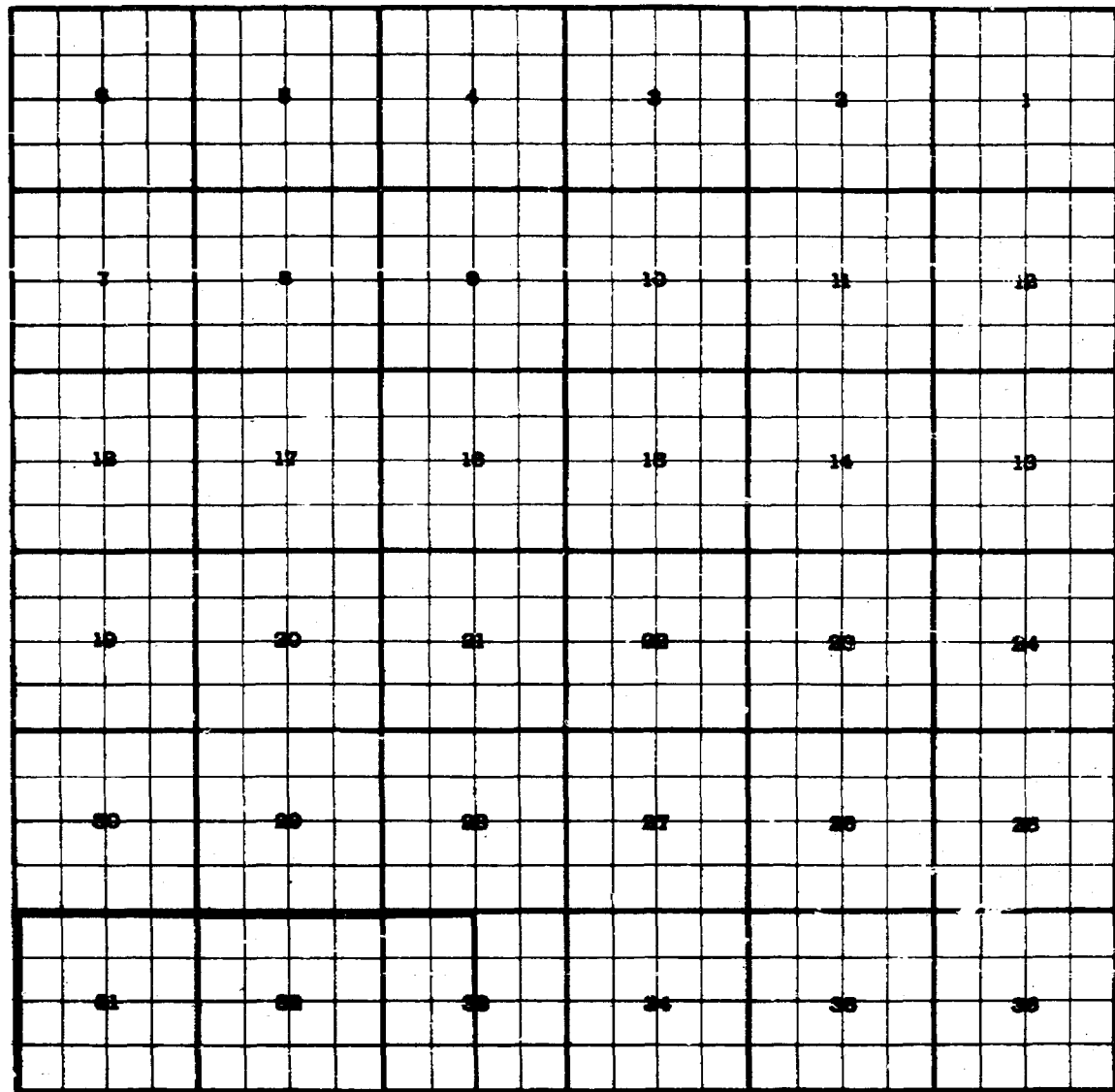
TOWNSHIP 16 South, RANGE 36 East, NEW MEXICO PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN

County Lee Pool Lovington-Abo

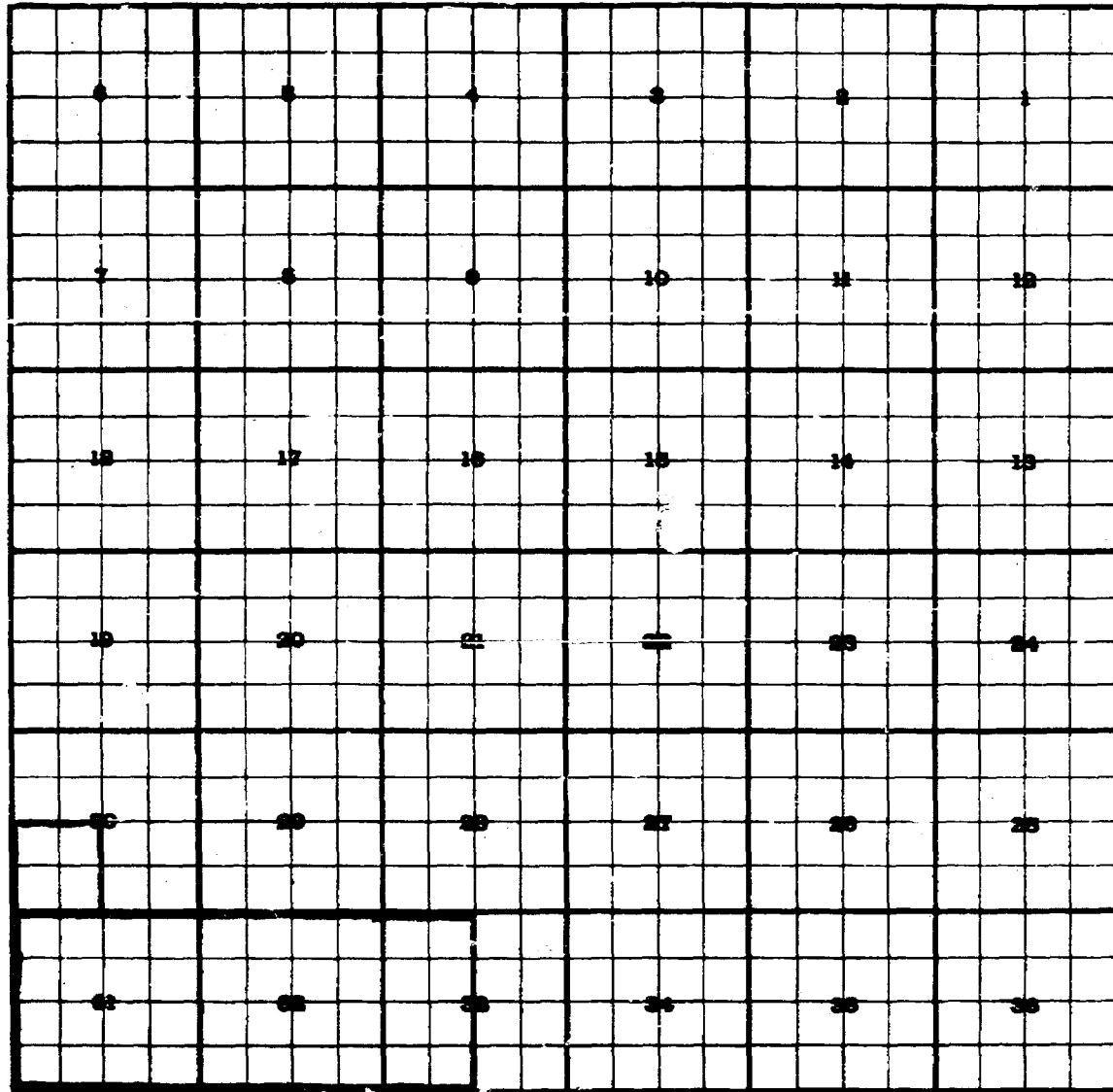
TOWNSHIP 16 South, RANGE 37 East, NEW MEXICO PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN

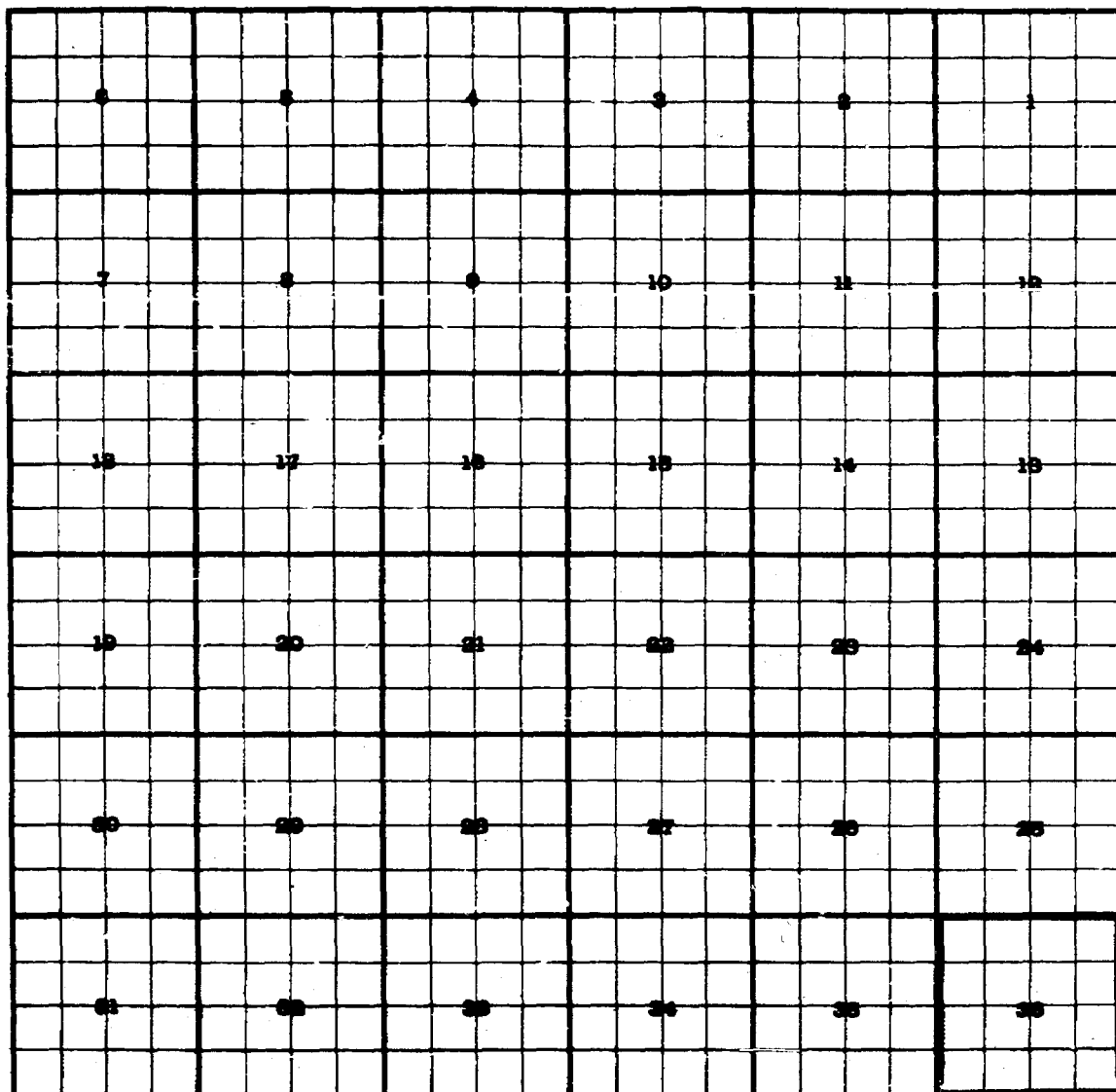

County Lea Pool Livingston - Paddock

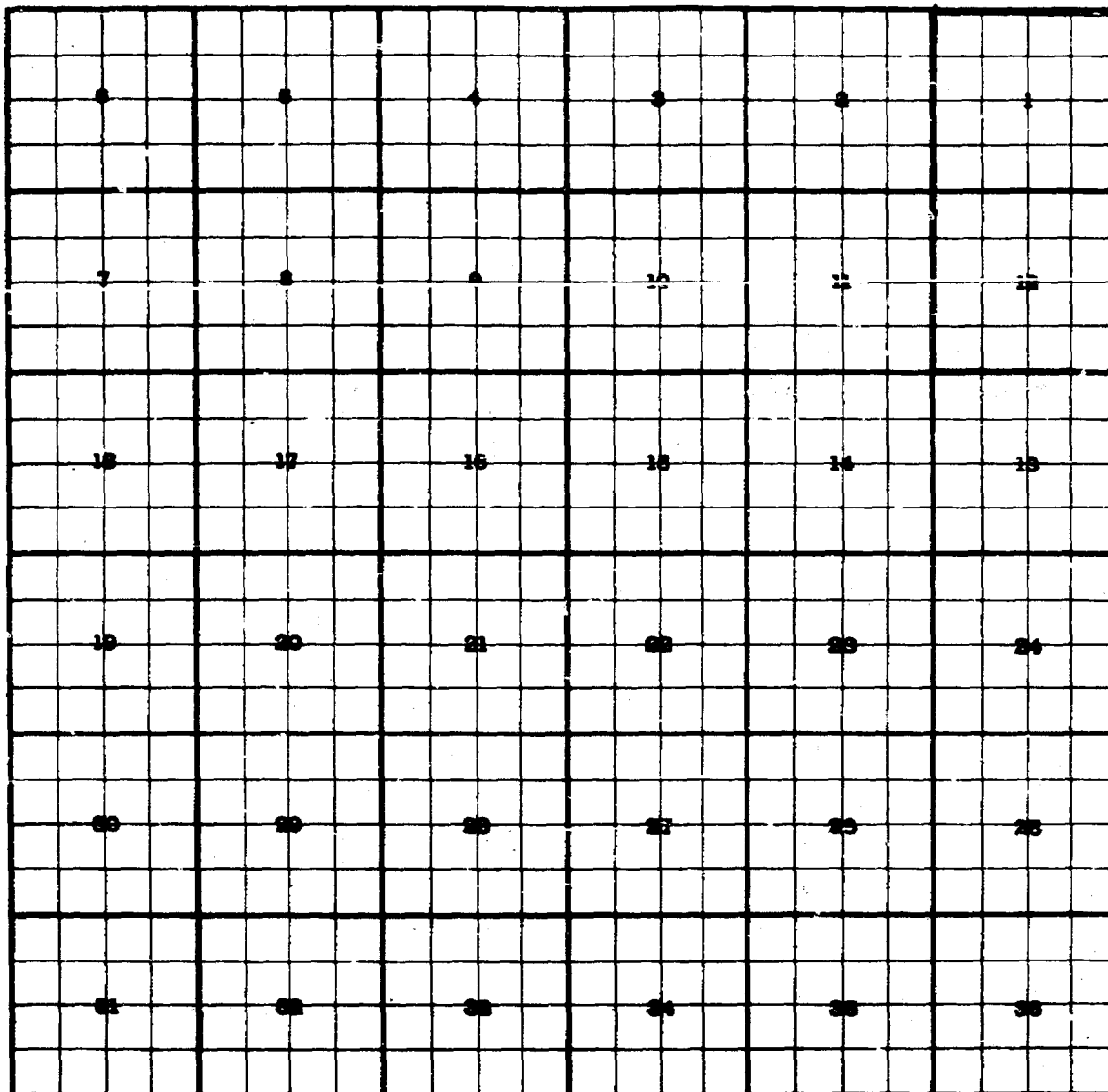
TOWNSHIP 16 South, RANGE 36 East, NEW MEXICO PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN

County Lea Pool Lovington-Paddeck

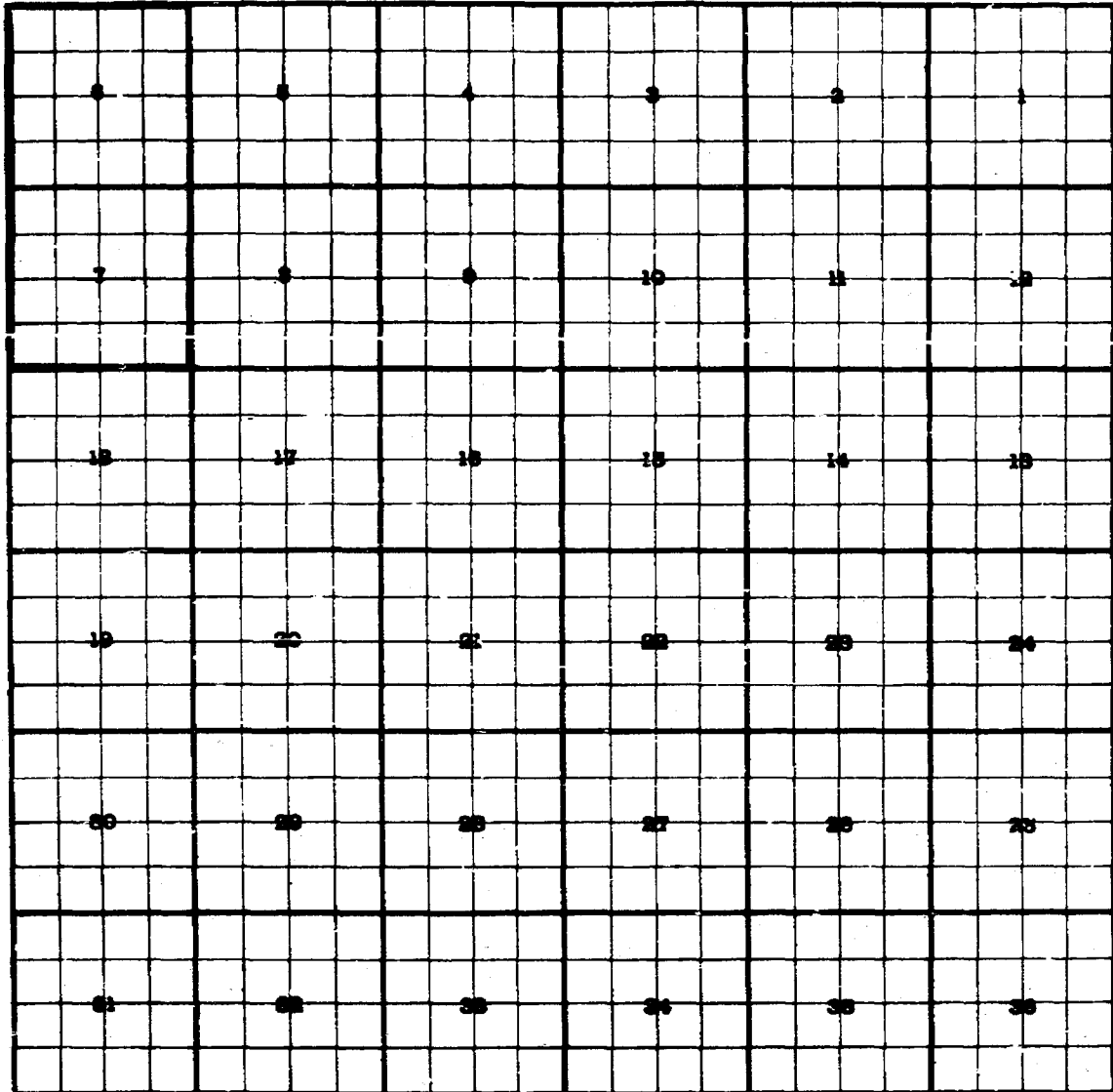
TOWNSHIP 17 South, RANGE 36 East, NEW MEXICO PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN

County Lea Pool Lovington - Paddock

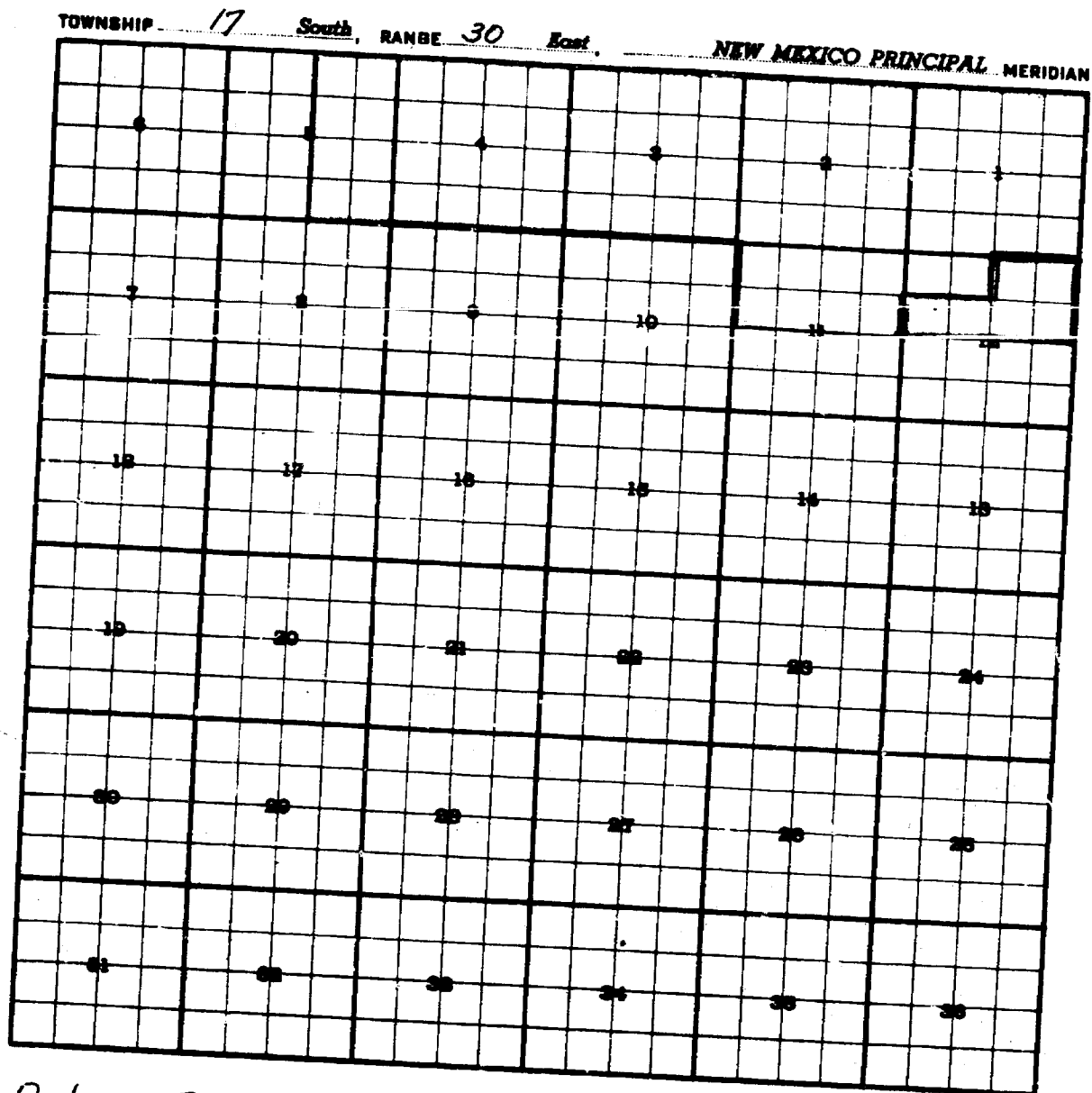

Pool Square Lake



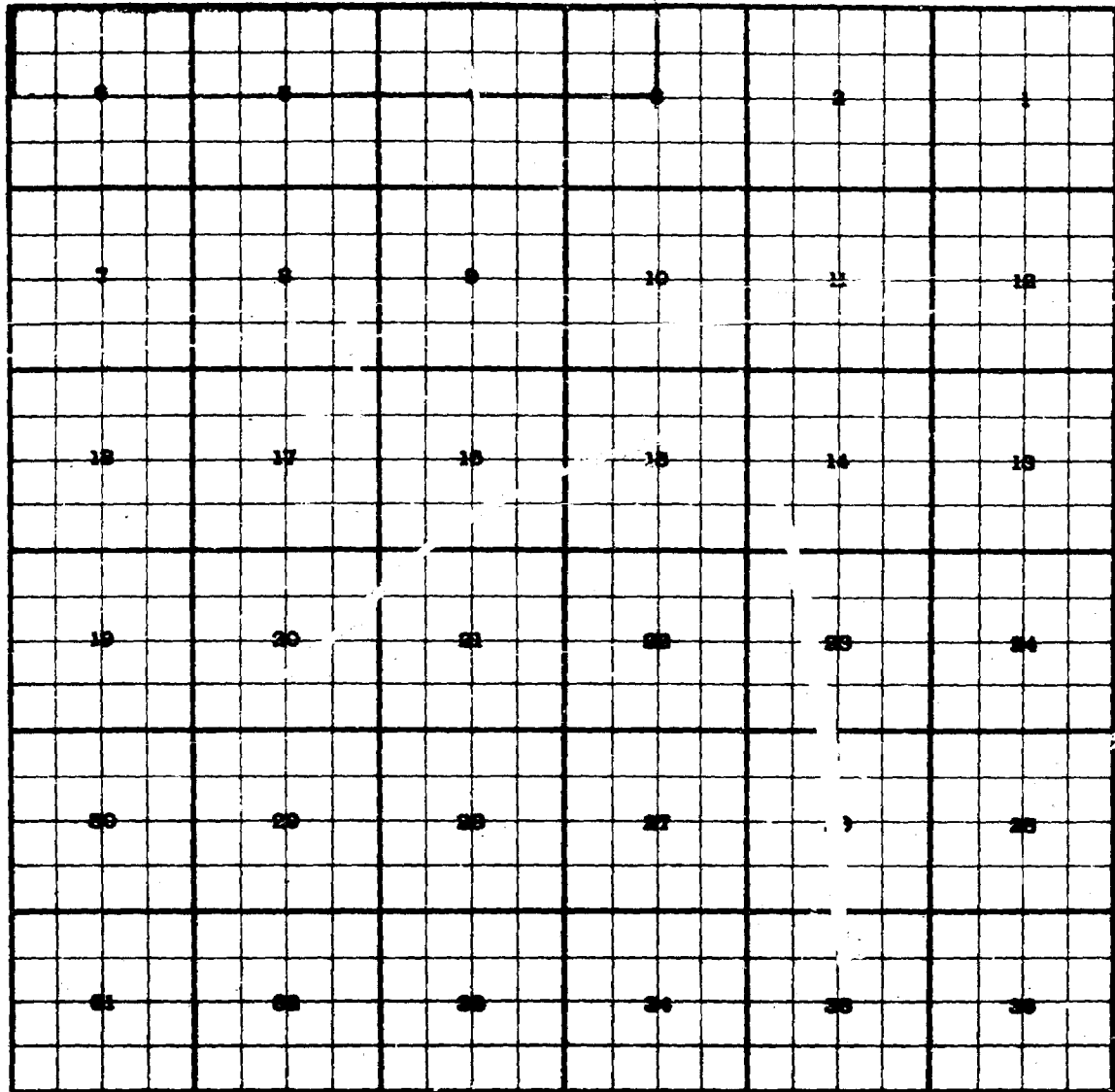

TOWNSHIP 17 South, RANGE 31 East, NEW MEXICO PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN

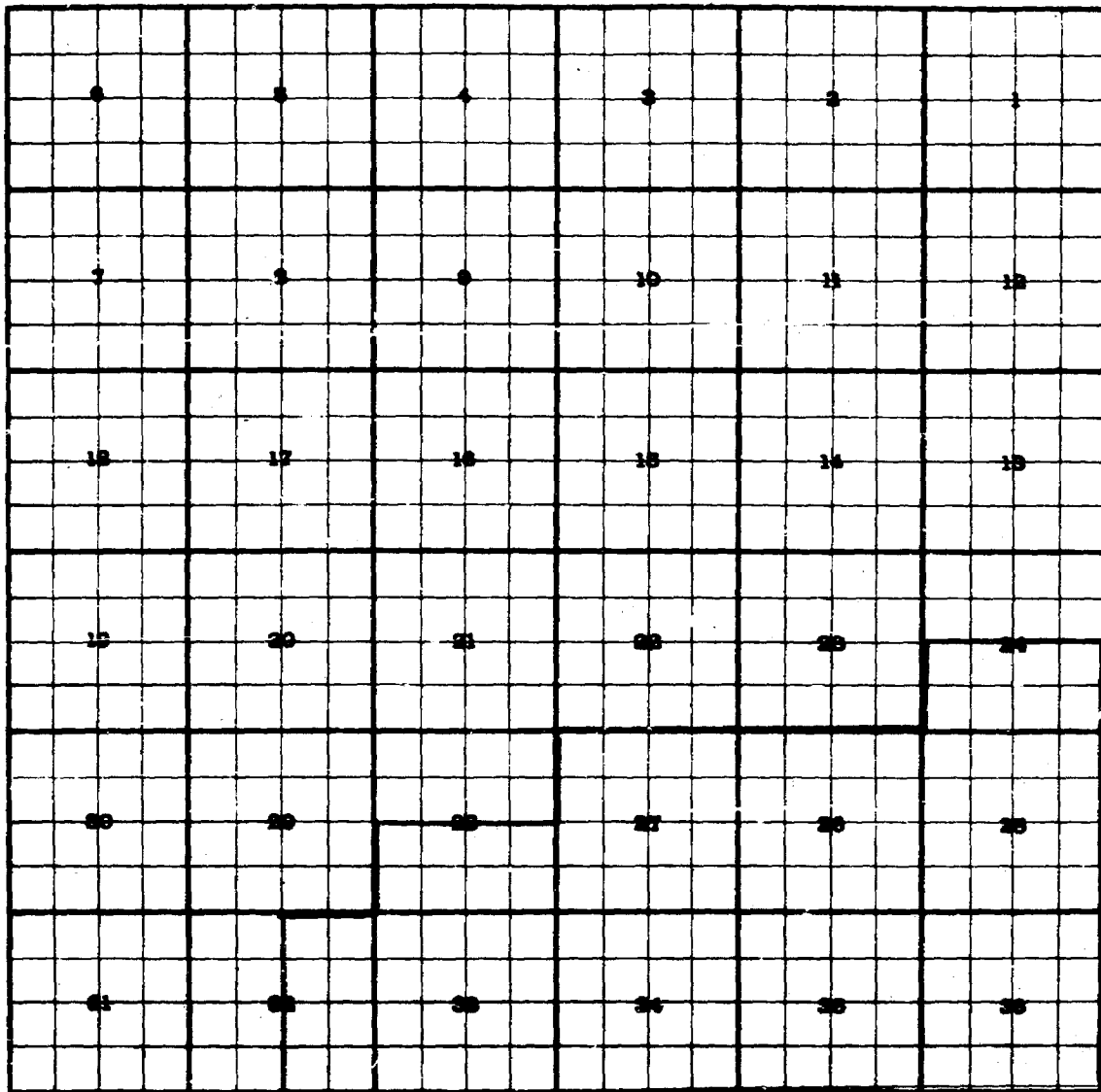

TOWNSHIP 16 South, RANGE 30 East, NEW MEXICO PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN

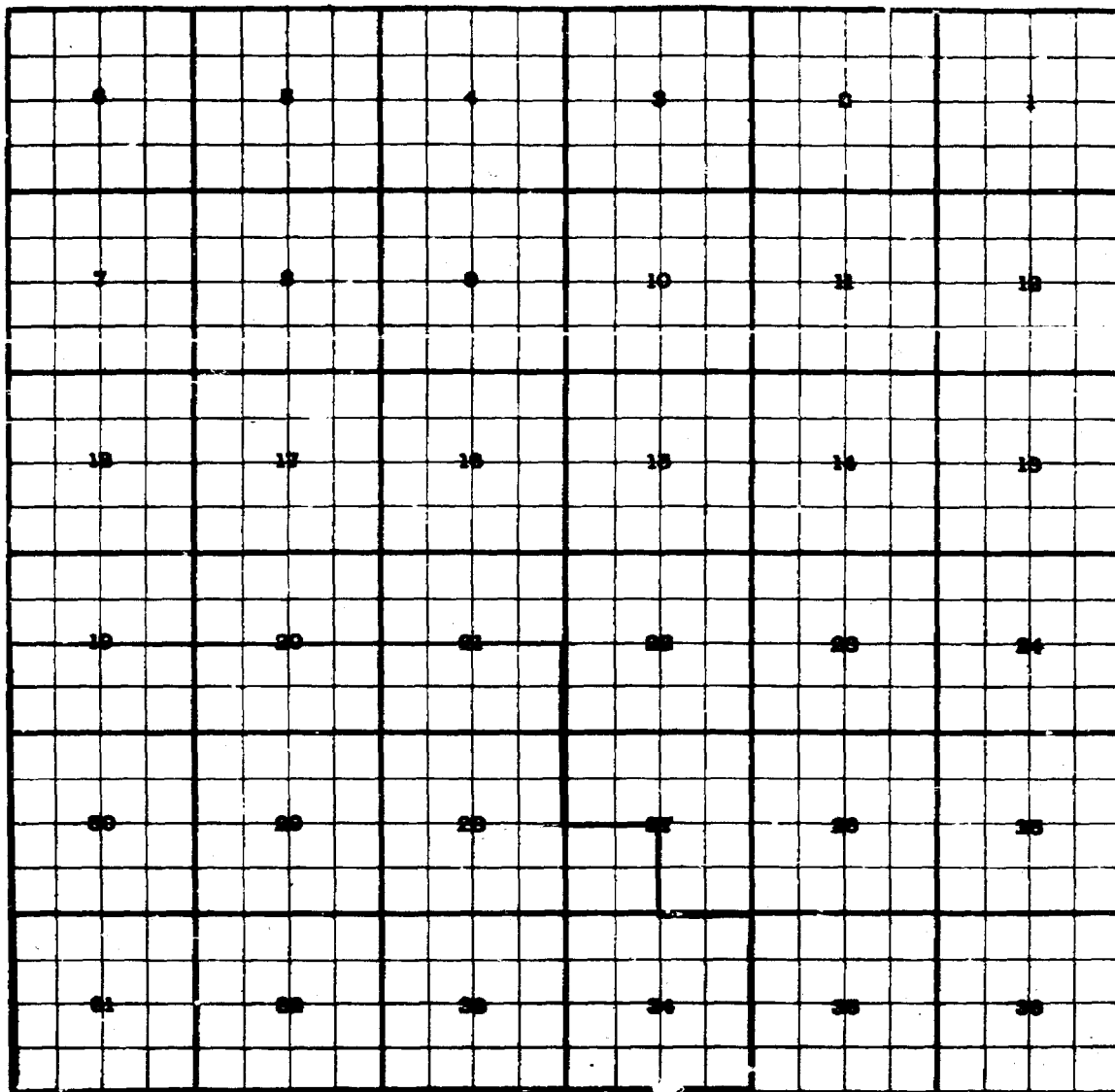

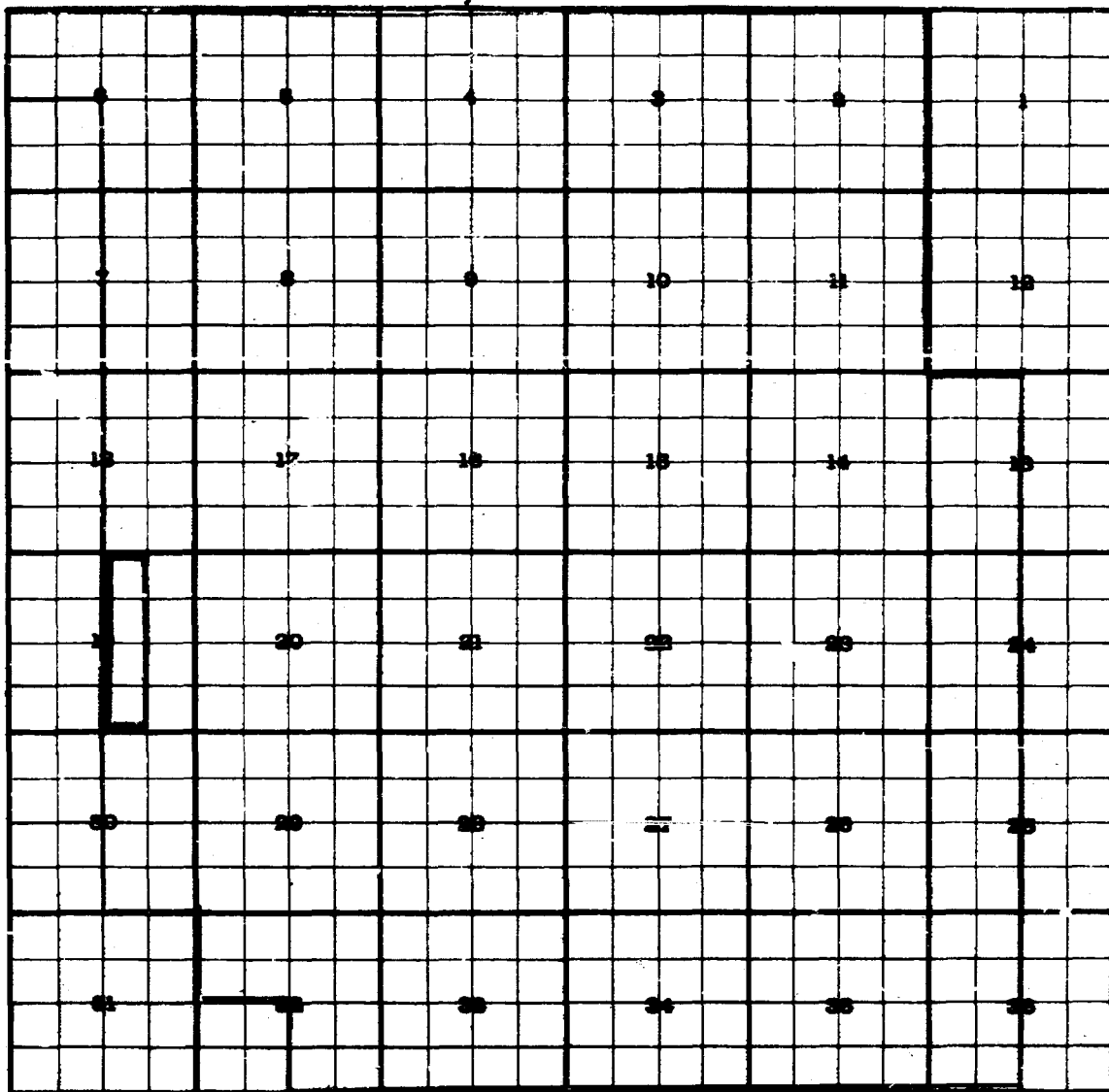
TOWNSHIP 16 South, RANGE 31 East, NEW MEXICO PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN

TOWNSHIP 25 South, RANGE 37 East, NEW MEXICO PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN

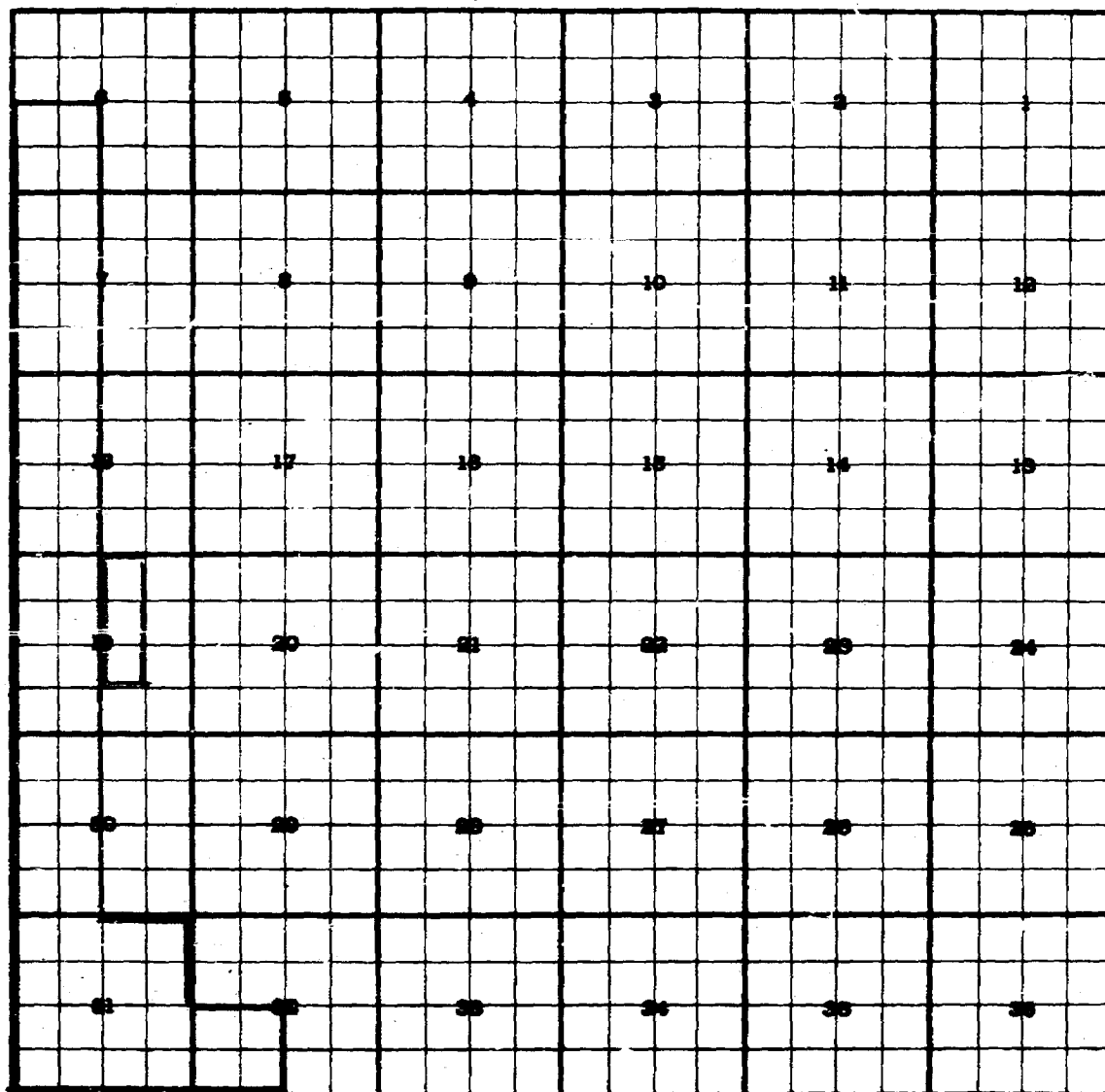
