THE APPLICATION OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION UPON ITS OWN MOTION FOR AN ORDER EXEMPTING THE SOUTH LEONARD OIL POOL FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF RULE 506 (PARAGRAPH 'D') PERTAINING TO GAS-OIL RATIO LIMITATIONS, AND FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF RULE 301 PERTAINING TO THE FILING OF FORM C-116, GAS-OIL RATIO TEST.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on February 17, 1954, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 26 day of February, 1954, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the evidence presented in the case, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises,

FINDS

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the South Leonard Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, should, by reason of its low productivity of oil and gas, be exempted from:
 - (a) The provisions of Paragraph 'd' of Rule 506 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, said rule relating to gas-oil ratio limitations.
 - (b) The provisions of Rule 301 of the Rules and Regulations pertaining to the filing of Form C-116, Gas-Oil Ratio Test.
- (3) That the Langlie-Mattix Oil Pool, the Rhodes Oil Pool and the Leonard Oil Pool, all of which lie within the immediate vicinity of the subject South Leonard Oil Pool, have by previous order (Order R=399 entered in Case 390) been removed from restrictions identical to those contained in the current application, and that therefore no inequities would arise from the granting of this application.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the South Leonard Oil Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, be and it hereby is exempted from the provisions of Rules 301 and 506 of the Oil Conservation Commission's Rules and Regulations, same to be effective as of March 1. 1954.

Form C-116, Gas-Oil Ratio Test. You are acquainted with the subject matter of this case, are you not? A Yes, sir.

Q Will you please give the commission the benefit of your observations in the matter and any recommendation that you might care to make?

A South Leonard Pool is located in Township 26 South, Range 37 East, Sections 23 and 24. It is in an area which is south of the Langlie Mattix Oil Pool and east of the Rhodes Pool. It is also in the immediate area of the Leonard Oil Pool. The Commission has previously removed the Gas-Oil Ratio limit from these three pools. The south Leonard Pool has 14 producing wells which have an average productivity of five barrels per day. The gas production averages 60,000 cubic feet per well per day. All of the casinghead gas is, to the best of our knowledge, being sold to gasoline plants operating in the area. Since the field is obviously a marginal field and the income from the property is very limited, it is requested that this Commission enter an order removing the Gas-Oil Ratio limit and also exempting the field from the requirements of filing annual Gas-Oil Ratio tests.

MR. SPURRIER: Are there any questions of the witness?

If not, the witness may be excused.

(Witness excused.)

MR. SPURRIER: Does anyone have anything further in this case? We will take the case under advisement and move on to Case 670.
