

By this letter of application Sun Oil Company wishes to state the following:

1. Sun Oil Company owns lease on W/2 of E/2 and SE/4 of NE/4 and NE/4 of SE/4 of Section 35, T-19-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico, consisting of 240 contiguous acres.
2. Sun Oil Company has one gas well, being W. B. Maveety No. 5 on this lease located in SW/4 of NE/4 of said Section 35.
3. Shell Oil Company has lease on SE/4 of SE/4 on which they have one gas well, being State 1-A.
4. Gulf Oil Corporation has lease on NE/4 of NE/4, being their W. A. Weir.
5. Repeated efforts to form 160 acre units in accordance with the Field Rules have been unsuccessful.
6. Additional drilling on the E/2 of Section 35 for the purpose of adequately draining the reservoir is unnecessary.
7. Sun Oil Company respectfully requests a hearing be called for the purpose of securing Commission approval of an unorthodox unit consisting of 240 acres, as set out in No. 1 above, and for assignment of allowable on the basis of 240 acres.
8. Sun Oil Company will form orthodox 160 acre units at any time other operators in the E/2 of Section 35 desire.
