Gentlemen:

This is written in response to your request of September 2, that we connect and purchase the casinghead gas produced from the No. 1 Well on your Christmas lease, which is described as the NE/4 SE/4 of Section 17-22S-37E, Lea County, New Mexico.

Content and volume tests indicate that there would be approximately 50 thousand cubic feet of gas per day, testing .9 gallon per thousand, available for processing. Our operating people advise that it would require 2,800 feet of pipe to make the tie in, that the total cost of the installation, including meter and meter setting, would exceed \$3,000.00, and that the connection can not be justified under these circumstances.

We regret therefore to advise you that we shall not be able to give you a connection to this property at this time, but if additional production should be obtained, or if factors involving costs and income from the gas should change for the better, we shall be glad to review the matter.

Mr. Guy R. Zachry with the Radford Zachry Oil Company, Inc. has asked that we give him a letter as to whether or not we can tie in their Number 1 Christmas well located in the NE/4 SE/4 Section 17-22S-37E.

I doubt very much if we could afford to go the 2,800' required to pick up this gas. Our test shows a volume of 54 mcf per day with a gpm of .923 at twenty pounds separator pressure.

Will you furnish Mr. Zachry with a letter if you agree with me that we cannot afford to tie the gas into our gathering system?
