Dear Sire

In conjuction with the bearing of the Hillips #1, I would appreciate very much if at the same time we could have bearing on locations 2 and 3, located in Sections 10 and 11, Township 28 N, Renge 15 W in Sen Juan County, New Mexico.

These locations were staked by Frnest V. Fohohawk, Registered Land Surveyor, on the only accessable terrain that would lie within the units desired, being location # 2, 1630 feet from the East line and 840 feet from the North line of Section 11 T-28N, K-13W. To this location it is desirous to allocate lots 1, 2, 3, and 4 in Section 11, and 1 and 2 in Section 10, consisting of178 cores more or less. The accompanying plats show the location and the offset operators.

Phillips # 3 being located 1140 feet from the South line and 490 feet from the East line of Section 10 T-28 H, R-13 W. It is desired to allocate the South half of Section 10 consisting of 160 acres more or less to this location. The accompanying plat shows all offset operators.
