TRAMSCRIPT OF HEARING

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MR. MACRY: The next case on the docket is Case 885.

S. J. STANLEY,

called as a witness, having been previously duly sworn, testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

By MR. KITTS:

Q You are the same Mr. Stanley who just testified in the last two cases?

A Yes.sir.

Q You are familiar with Case 885?

A Yes, sir, I am.

Q Mr. Stanley, in Paragraphs (a) through (f), you have a certain recommendation to make for extensions of various pools to include the areas therein set forth. Will you, in each instance, (a) through (f), state the reason for the recommendation and the basis for that recommendation?

A In Case 885, Paragraph (a), I recommend that the extension be made as advertised, to include the area caused by the drilling of a well by the Makin Drilling Company, Warlick No. 1, in Section 19, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, a Blinebry completion, with the top to perforation at 5,585.

Case 885, Paragraph (b), I recommend that the area be extended as advertised, occasioned by the drilling of a well by G. E. Hall, Dura H Crockett No. 1, in Section 21, Township 15 South, Range 36 East. In Case 885, Paragraph (c), I recommend that the area be extended

as advertised, occasioned by the drilling of two wells, the T. J. Sivley Fox Federal No. 1, completed as a Queen producer with the depth to the casing shoe at 4,373 feet and also another well, the T. J. Sivley Federal No. 19 - 1 in Section 19, Township 18 South, Range 34 East, also a Queen producer.

In Case 885, Paragraph (d), extension to the Eumont Pool as advertised, to incorporate two wells. They are the Skelly Oil Company New Mexico W No. 4, in Section 2, Township 21 South, Range 35 East, and also the Wilson Oil Company, Eumont State No. 1 in Section 2, Township 21 South, Range 35 East, both producing from the vertical limits of the Eumont Gas Pool.

In Case 885, Paragraph (e), I recommend that the pool be extended as advertised, occasioned by the drilling of a well, the Westates Petroleum Corporation Carlson No. 1, B-1 in Section 1, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, producing in the Queen, top of the perforation is 3,340 feet.

Also in Case 885, Sub-Paragraph (f), to include the areas advertised in the Skaggs Pool, to include the Signal Oil and Gas Weir No. 1 in Section 6, Township 20 South, Range 38 East, and the Signal Oil and Gas Company Dan Glade No. 1 in Section 6, Township 20 South, Range 38 East; both being Grayburg producers.

I might also revert back to Case 885, Paragraph (d), this case has not been advertised, but it is contiguous to the Eumont Pool, therefore, I would like to extend the Eumont Pool to include all of Sections 5 and 6 in Township 21 South, Range 37 East. I might add that these are long sections and therefore, include theentire section. These sections are approximately a mile and a half long in the north and south direction. That is to include the Schermer-

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horn Gil Corporation, Darney Curry Number 1, a stas well, producing from the vertical limits of the Rumont Pool in Section 5, Township 21 South, Range 37 Sast.

Q Have you shown that on your exhibit there?

A Yes, I have.

Q You have prepared Exhibits (a) through (f), incorporating the recommendations for extensions that you have made, is that right?

A Yes, sir.

(Marked Commission's Staff Exhibits (a) through (f) inclusive, for identification.)

MR. KITTS: We offer in evidence Commission's Staff Exhibits (a) through (f), inclusive.

MR. MACEY: Without objection they will be received. I have one question pertaining to Paragraph (c). I just noticed that your recommendation includes the northwest quarter of Section 19. It is the only acreage in Section 19 that is included in the proposed extension and the well in Section 19 is located in the southwest portion. The location may be wrong on the exhibit. It is the same way on the proration schedule as being in the southwest quarter. That is the Sivley No. 1 Federal 19. We will include the west half of Section 18, Township 18 South, Range 34 East in the proposed extension.

A Yes, sir.

MR. MACEY: Without objection they will be received. Any questions of Mr. Stanley? If not the witness will be excused.

(Witness excused.)

MR. MACEY: We will take the case under advisement.

THE APPLICATION OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION UPON ITS OWN MOTION FOR AN ORDER CALLING FOR THE EXTENSION OF EXISTING POOLS IN LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on April 20, 1955, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this $\frac{\pi}{2}$ day of May, 1955, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as prescribed by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That extensions as advertised, and as further amended by testimony presented at the subject hearing, should be approved for the Blinebry Gas Pool, the Caudill-Devonian Oil Pool, the E-K Queen Oil Pool, the Eumont Gas Pool, the Langlie-Mattix Oil Pool, and the Skaggs Oil Pool.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the application of the Oil Conservation Commission upon its own motion be, and the same hereby is approved as follows:

(a) That the Blinebry Gas Pool, as heretofore classified, defined and described, should be extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM All of Section 17; SE/4 Section 18; NE/4 Section 19; all of Section 20

(b) That the Caudill-Devonian Pool, as heretofore classified, defined and described, should be extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM All of Section 21 -2-Order No. R-631

(c) That the E-K Queen Pool, as heretofore classified, defined and described, should be extended to include therein:

> TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 34 EAST, NMPM W/2 Section 18; W/2 Section 19

(d) That the Eumont Gas scool, as heretofore classified, defined and described, should be extended to include therein:

> TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 35 EAST, NMPM Lots 1, 2, 7, 8, 9, 10, 15 and 16 of Section 2

TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM All of Sections 5 and 6

(e) That the Langlie-Mattix Pool, as heretofore classified, defined and described, should be extended to include therein:

> TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM W/2 Section 1

(f) That the Skaggs Pool, as heretofore classified, defined and described, should be extended to include therein:
