Re: Revision of Form C-110

Dear Mr. Macey:

I am enclosing a copy of Form C-110, revised as I believe it should be. As you examine the proposed form I believe a number of improvements will be obvious, but the main reasons why I am proposing the revised form are:

1. The revised form will show both the oil and gas transporters and will be filed in quintuplicate so that both transporters may be sent an approved copy, thereby eliminating the necessity of the operator having to file separate forms for oil and gas, when both connections have been made.
2. It provides a space for the operator to indicate the disposition of casinghead gas in the event that it is not being sold. If a gas connection has not been made at the time the C-110 is filed, another form may be filed for the gas connection later, but the fact that a connection is anticipated could be registered on the original C-110. This is essential information for the enforcement of "No-flare" regulations.

I think only one word of Rule 1309 would need to be changed, and that is the number of copies.

If this meets with your approval I would like to distribute the proposed form at the April hearing, explain it, and advertise it for the May hearing.

TRANSCRIPT OF HEARING

MR. MACEY: The next case is 905. Mr. Porter, do you have
a statement you want to make in connection with this matter?

MR. PORTER: I believe copies of the proposed Form C-110
were circulated at the last hearing. I think the reason for the
proposed changes are obvious. I might review them.

In the first place this form has a space for the showing of
both the casinghead gas transporter and the oil transporter which
would eliminate the necessity of having to file two separate forms.
Then you will notice in the body of the form there is a space to
explain the disposition of casinghead gas if a connection is not
available at the time that the well is completed. I believe it
would necessitate the changing of only one word in Rule 1109, and
that is as to the number of copies to be filed. The new form would
require five copies so that one copy could be sent to the authorized
transporter of casinghead gas.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a. m., on May 18, 1955, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this 20th day of June, 1955, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony adduced at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due notice of hearing having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this case and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That Rule 1109 of the official Rules and Regulations, which rule relates to Certificate of Compliance and Authorization to Transport Oil and Natural Gas, should be revised and clarified.

(3) That Commission Form C-110, 'Certificate of Compliance and Authorization to Transport Oil and Natural Gas', should be revised as set out in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That Rule 1109 of Section 'M' of the official Rules and Regulations of the Commission be, and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

RULE 1109: CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE AND
AUTHORIZATION TO TRANSPORT OIL
AND NATURAL GAS - (FORM C-110):

- (a) Each producer of crude petroleum oil, casinghead gas, liquid hydrocarbons, and natural gas shall execute, in QUINTUPLICATE, and file Form C-110 with the Commission, setting forth fully therein the data and information indicated by such form covering each well from which crude petroleum oil, casinghead gas, natural gas or liquid hydrocarbons are produced.
- (b) Whenever there shall occur a change in operating ownership of any producing well or whenever there shall occur a change of transporter from any producing well, Form C-110 shall be executed and filed in accordance with instructions; except that in the case of a temporary change in transporter involving less than the allowable for one proration period the producer may, in lieu of filing a new application, notify the Commission, and the transporter then authorized, by a letter of the estimated amount of crude petroleum, casinghead gas, dry gas or liquid hydrocarbons to be moved by the temporary transporter and a copy of such notice shall also be furnished such temporary transporter. In no instance shall the temporary transporter move any greater quantity of crude petroleum oil, liquid hydrocarbons or natural gas than the estimated amount shown in said notice.

(2) Commission Form C-110 is hereby revised as set out in Exhibit "A" hereto attached and made a part hereof.

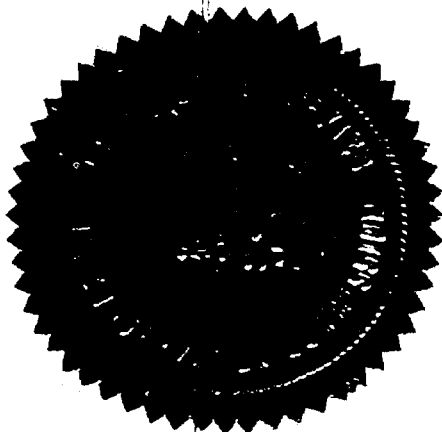
