ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on May 18, 1955, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 13<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1955, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received in said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as prescribed by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That extension as advertised, and as further amended by testimony presented at the subject hearing, should be approved for the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the application of the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico be, and the same hereby is approved as follows:

(a) That the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, as previously classified, defined and described, should be extended to include therein:

All of partial Section 8;  
all of Section 17

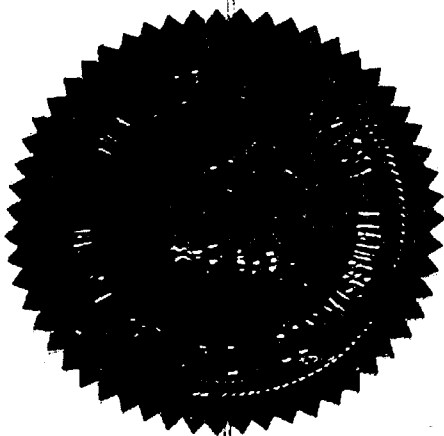

ELVIS A. UTZ,

called as a witness, having been first duly sworn, testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

By MR. RHODES:

Q State your name and position for the Commission, please.

A Elvis A. Utz, Engineer for the Oil Conservation Commission.

Q Mr. Utz, in connection with Case 907, pertaining to the nomenclature of gas pools in Northern New Mexico, do you have any recommendations you would like to make as to the subject matter set out in this case?

A Yes, I have.

Q Will you state your recommendations and give the basis for these recommendations?

A Yes, I will. All my recommendations have to do with the Aztec Pictured Cliffs Pool, and I recommend that all these recommendations be adopted as advertised.

Q Mr. Utz, have you prepared an exhibit in connection with this case?

A Yes, I have.

Q Would you describe those exhibits to the Commission, please?

A I have an exhibit which lists all the extensions as advertised, together with the wells on which these recommendations are based. I have also added to this exhibit, one location which has not been advertised, and which I will read into the record and recommend that it be adopted as part of the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs pooling. This is Township 29 North, Range 11 West, Section 5, southeast quarter. This extension is based on the El Paso Natural

Gas Company pool Unit No. 2, which is located in the southeast quarter of Section 5, Township 29 North, Range 11 West, with an IP of 1,032,000 MCF.

Q Were those exhibits prepared by you, or under your supervision?

A Yes, they were.

(Marked Commission's Exhibit "A" in case 907, for identification.)

MR. RHODES: I would like to introduce that as Exhibit "A" in Case 907.

MR. MACEY: Without objection it will be received in evidence. Any questions of the witness? If not the witness may be excused.

(Witness excused.)

MR. MACEY: Anything further in this case? We will take the case under advisement.
