

Gentlemen:

On December 6, 1954, Gulf Oil Corporation made written application for an exception to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission's Order No. R-520 in regard to the creation of a 200-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool to be located in Section 23, T-19-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico. By your letter of January 10, 1955, we were advised that according to Rule 5(a), Paragraph 3, of Order No. R-520, 160 acres is the maximum acreage that could be assigned administratively to our R. R. Bell "H" Well No. 1 because of the well's location in respect to the south and east boundaries.

Therefore, Gulf Oil Corporation hereby resubmits the application for a 200-acre non-standard gas proration unit, comprising the NE/4 and the NM/4 of the SE/4, Section 23, T-19-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico, to be assigned to its R. R. Bell "H" Well No. 1 in the Eumont Gas Pool. It is respectfully requested that the Commission place this matter on its Docket for the next regular Statewide Hearing on May 18, 1955.

The following facts are offered in support of this application:

- (1) Gulf Oil Corporation is the owner and operator of the 200-acre oil and gas lease known as the R. R. Bell "H" Lease, Lea County, New Mexico, as shown on the attached plat.
- (2) Gulf Oil Corporation proposes that the abovedescribed acreage be established as a nonstandard 200-acre gas provation unit in exception to Rule 5(a) of Order No. R-520.
- (3) The R. R. Bell "H" Well No. 1, located 1980 feet from the north line and 660 feet from the east

line, Section 23, T-19-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico, was completed on June 6, 1954, at a depth of 3915 feet as a gas well in the Eumont Gas Pool, and is producing from within the vertical limit of said gas pool as defined in New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission's Order No. R-520. The applicant proposes to use this well as the unit well.

(4) No other amont Gas well is completed on the 200acre proration unit proposed under this application.

## ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

## BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for bearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on May 18, 1955, at Santa Fe, New Mexico before the Oil Conservation Commission, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

MOW, on this 25th day of June, 1955, the Commission, a quotum being present, having considered the record and the testimony address at said hearing and being fully advised in the premises,

#### FINDS:

- (1) That due notice of the time and place of hearing and the purpose thereof having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the Commission has the power and authority to permit the formation of a gas provation unit consisting of other than a legal section after notice and hearing by the Commission.
- (3) That applicant, Gulf Oil Corporation, is the owner of oil and gas leases in Lea County, New Mexico, which leases cover lands comprising other than a legal section and described as follows:

TOWNSHIP 19 COUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM Section 23: NE/4, NW/4 SE/4

containing 200 acres more or less.

- (4) That applicant, Gulf Oil Corporation, has a producing gas well on the aforesaid leases which well is known as applicant's R. R. Bell "If" Well No. 1, lecated 1980 feet FNL and 660 feet FEL of Section 23, Township 19 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.
- (5) That the aforesaid well was completed an a gas well in the Eumont Gas Pool on June 6, 1954, and is producing from within the horisontal and vertical limits of said gas pool as such limits are defined by Commission Order R-520 and subsequent pertinent orders.
- (6) That it is impractical to pool applicant's aforesaid leases with adjoining acreage and that the owners of adjoining acreage have not objected to the fermation of the proposed proration unit.
- (7) That unless a proration unit consisting of applicant's aforesaid acreage is permitted, applicant will be deprived of the opportunity to recover his just and equitable share of the natural gas in the Eumont Gas Pool.
- (8) That the creation of a proration unit consisting of the aforesaid acreage will prevent waste, and will pretect correlative rights.

### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the application of Gulf Oil Corporation for approval of an unorthodex gas proration unit consisting of the following described acreage be, and the same is hereby approved, and a proration unit consisting of the following described acreage is hereby created:

TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM Section 23: NE/4, NW/4 SE/4

centaining 200 acres more or less.

(2) That applicant's well, R. R. BELL "H" Well No. 1, located 1980 feet FNL and 660 feet FEL of Section 23, Township 19 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, in the Eument Gas Pool, shall be granted an allowable which allowable shall be in the proportion that the above described 300 acre non-standard or unorthodox gas proration unit bears to the standard or erthodox proration unit for the Eument Gas Pool, all until further order of the Commission.

MR. MACEY: We will proceed to Case 912.

having previously been sworn, testified as follows:

### DIRECT EXAMINATION

## By MR. MALONE:

Q You are the same Don Walker who testified in the two preceeding cases on behalf of Gulf? A Yes, sir.

MR. MALONE: We adopt the testimony in the other records as to his qualification and experience and the Commission ruling thereon.

- Q Are you familiar with the application filed by Gulf Oil Corporation in Case 912?

  A I am.
  - Q What is the purpose of that application?
- A Purpose of the application was to obtain approval of a 200-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont gas poor to consist of the northeast quarter and the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 23, township 19. Range 36 east.

Q Have you caused plats to be prepared showing the proposed unit, its relation to other approved units in the area, and a contouring of the top of the Yates? A Yes, sir.

MR. MALONE: We ask that the exhibits be marked 1, 2, 3 and 4.

(Marked Gulf's Exhibits Nos. 1, 2, 3, and 4, for identification.)

- Q What is the well to which the acreage will be attributed in the event of the approval of application?
- A This is Gulf's R. R. Bell "H" No. 1 located 1980 feet from the north line and 660 feet from the east line of Section 23, Township 19 south, Range 36 east.
  - Q How much acreage is now attributed to that well?
  - A 160.
  - Q The application merely seeks to add an additional 40 acres
  - A That is right.
  - Q The 40 acres is described as what?
- A The northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 23, Township 19 south, Range 36 east.
- Q Who is the owner of the leasehold estate in all of the acreage included in the unit?

  A Gulf Oil Corporation.
  - Q Who is the owners of the royalty interest?
  - A State of New Mexico.
- Q Have you testified as to the location of this well with reference to the boundaries of the proposed unit?
  - A I believe I have, yes, sir.
  - Q Will you give us a brief history of the well?
- A This well was completed on June 6, 1954 at a depth of 3915 feet as a gas well in the Eumont Gas Pool. It is producing

from the vertical limits of this pool as we show on the attached, I mean on the log which we marked Exhibit 4.

- Q You have a radioactivity log of the well?
- A Yes.

MR. MALONE: We ask that the log be marked Exhibit 4.

(Marked Gulf's Exhibit No. 4, for identification.)

Q What information do you have as to ability of the well to produce the additional allowable if this application is approved?

A The present is, approximate flow, 770 M.C.F. per day with the addition of 40 acre allowable assigned, it would make it about 970 M.C.F. per day, and a test September 10, 1954, the well produced 1,536 M.C.F. at 733 P.S.I.A, atmospheric wellhead pressure.

- Q In your opinion is all of the acreage included in the proposed unit reasonably to be assumed to be productive of gas?
  - A Yes, sir.
  - Q On what do you base that conclusion?
- A We base that conclusion on the fact that the well is productive of gas. It has a north offset productive and one on the east productive of gas. The contours indicate that the area to the west should be productive of gas.
- Q Did you give notice to adjoining operators at the time that application was made for administrative approval of this unit?
  - A We did.
  - Q Any protests received? A None.
- Q In your opinion is the approval of the unit necessary to permit Gulf to recover its equitable and just share of the gas in the pool?

  A Yes, sir.

Q If the unit is not approved, would it require the drilling of an additional well to accomplish that?

A It would.

Q In your opinion would the approval of the application prevent waste and protect correlative rights?

A Yes, sir.

MR. MALONE: We offer in evidence Gulf's Exhibits 1, 2, 3 and 4.

MR. MACEY: Without objection they will be received.

A This well is tied into the Permian Fipeline Company, seven inch casing set at 3680, total depth 3915, and is producing from the open hole.

MR. MACEY: Any questions of the witness.

By MR. REIDER:

CROSS EXAMINATION

- Q Is that well completed to the Queen?
- A Yes, sir.
- Q It is producing some fluid right now?
- A Yes, sir.
- Q What is the approximate volume of the fluid?
- A I believe in February measured 59 barrels for the month, which would give a ratio of around 380,000 as a rough calculation.
  - Q Do you have any figures since February?
  - A No, sir, I do not.
  - Q You wouldn't be aware whether it was increasing or not?
- A Apparently not. During the six or seven months that it produced last year, I believe the figure was around five or six hundred barrels total, which was approximately the same as the monthly figure I just gave. 641 barrels since June of 54. I assume that

is through February, this doesn't say.

Q There is a separator on the lease? Or is it producing directly into the line?

A That I don't know.

MR. MACEY: If you are measuring the crude, you must have some kind of separation?

A Must have.

MR. MACEY: Anyone else have a question? Anything further?

MR. MALONE: Nothing further.

MR. MACEY: If no further questions, the witness may be excused. We will take the case under advisement.



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
