TRANSCRIPT OF HEARING

MR. MACEY: The hearing will come to order, please. The first case will be Case 913. Is this your only witness?

MR. WHITE: Yes, sir. If the Commission please, the petitioner, Mid-Continent Petroleum Corporation, since the filing of this petition has been merged with the Sun-Ray Oil Corporation, and it has changed its name to the Sun-Ray Mid-Continent Oil Company. We should like to have the record show that it is the successor in interest to the petitioner's application here.

DONALD E. HALL,

having been first duly sworn, testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

By MR. WHITE:

Q State your full name for the record, please.

- A Donald E. Hall.
- Q By whom employed and in what capacity?
- A By Sunray Mid-Continent Oil Company as petroleum engineer.
- Q Where do you have your offices?
- A Midland, Texas.
- Q Have you ever testified before the Commission before?
- A No, sir.
- Q Will you state briefly your qualifications?
- A I was graduated from the University of Oklahoma in 1946; since then I have been employed as petroleum engineer by Barndall Oil Company, Sunray Oil Corporation, and Sunray Mid-Continent Oil Company over a period of seven years. During that time I have resided approximately four years in New Mexico and West Texas.
- Q Are you familiar with Mid-Continent's petition in Case Number 913?
 - A Yes, sir.

(Mid-Continent's Exhibit No. 1 marked for identification.)

- Q I hand you what has been marked Exhibit No. 1 and ask you to state what that is and what it is designed to show.
- A This is a plat of Sections 11 and 12, Township 21, South, Range 36 East; outlined in red is the proposed 160-acre proration unit of the C. W. Marshall No. 2. Also shown are surrounding gas wells which are producing from the same gas pay as our proposed unit well.
- Q This proposed acreage is to be assigned as described to C. W. Marshall Well No. 2?
 - A Yes, sir.

Q Will you give a brief history of the well?

A The C. W. Marshall No. 2 was completed September 25, 1936, in the Eumont Oil Pool. It is located 660 from the east line, 1980 from the south line of Section 11, Township 21 South, Range 36 East.

Q What do you propose to do with this well?

A We propose to plug back from the Eunice Pool into the Queen or Eumont gas zone.

(Mid-Continent's Exhibit No. 2 marked for identification)

Q I hand you what has been marked Exhibit No. 2 and ask you to state what that is?

A This is a waiver of objection to the proposed unit by Sinclair Dil and Gas Company.

(Mid-Continent's Exhibit No. 3 marked for identification.)

Q I hand you here what has been marked Exhibit No. 3 and ask you to state what that is.

A This is a waiver to objection to the proposed unit by Two-States Oil Company.

(Mid-Continent's Exhibit No. 4 marked for identification.)

Q I hand you Exhibit No. 4. Will you identify it?

A This is a waiver to the objection of the proposed unit by the Texas Company.

MR. WHITE: If no objection, we move the introduction of Exhibits 1 through 4 inclusive.

MR. MACEY: Without objection they will be received.

Q Is the proposed assigned acreage, in your opinion, reasonably

assumed to be productive?

- A Yes, sir.
- Q What is the basis for that conclusion?
- A There are wells on each side of the proposed unit within reasonable distance which, for all purposes, should prove the acreage to be productive.
- Q Do your lease agreements provide for pooling without consent of royalty owners?
 - A No, sir.
- Q In your opinion, is it practical to unitize this area or any portion of it with the surrounding tracts?
- A No, sir, it isn't, due to the existing spacing and proration unit surrounding the lease and for economic reasons.
- Q In your opinion, would the granting of this application cause waste or prejudice correlative rights?
 - A No, sir.

MR. WHITE: We have no further questions.

MR. MACEY: Any questions of the witness? Mr. Mankin.

CROSS EXAMINATION

By MR. MANKIN:

- Q Will the well be completed in only the Queen for gas pay?
- A The main producing zone is the Queen. Actually, part of the Seven Rivers and possibly the Yates might be productive in this area. It is pretty hard to tell without running a gamma ray neutron log just where we will perforate.
- Q. In this same unit area you have a well No. 3 that is presently carried as an oil well?

A Yes.

Q At one time it showed some gas; do you feel that any gas is being produced from the Eumont payout of this well?

A No, sir, not at the time. Possibly at one time a small stringer was productive in it, but at the present time the gas-oil ratio is 1,025 to 1, which is very well within the limits.

Q Would your company be willing to furnish the log that is later run on this well so it may be --

A (Interrupting) Yes, from the C. W. we will run a gamma ray neutron log and furnish that log.

MR. MACEY: Any other questions?

MR. WHITE: We should receive a waiver from Dalport which hasn't come in as yet.

MR. MACEY: If no further questions of the witness, the witness may be excused.

(Witness excused.)

MR. MACEY: Does anyone have anything further? Nothing further. We will take the case under advisement.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMESION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on June 13, 1955 at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this 17th day of August, 1955, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the records and testimony adduced and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due notice of the time and place of hearing and the purpose thereof having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this case and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That pursuant to provisions of Rule 5 (a) of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Eumont Gas Pool of Order No. R-520, the Commission has power and authority to permit the formation of a gas proration unit consisting of other than a legal section after notice and hearing by the Commission.
- (3) That applicant, Sunray Mid-Continent Oil Company is the owner of an oil and gas lease in Lea County, New Mexico the land consisting of other than a legal section, and described as follows, to-wit:

TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM E/2 SE/4 of Section 11 and W/2 SW/4 of Section 12

containing 160 acres, more or less.

- (4) That applicant, Sunray Mid-Continent Company has a producing well on the aforecaid lease known as the C. W. Marshall Well No. 2, located 1980 feet from the south line and 660 feet from the east line of Section II, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMFM, Lea County, New Mexico.
- (5) That the aforesaid well will be recompleted within the vertical and horizontal limits of the Eumont Gas Pool, as said pool is delineated and designated in Order No. R-520.
- (6) That it is impractical to pool applicant's said lease with adjoining acreage in the Eumont Gas Pool, and that the owners of adjoining acreage in said area have not objected to the formation of the proposed proration unit of 160 acres.
- (7) That unless a proration unit consisting of applicant's aferesaid acreage is permitted, applicant will be deprived of the opportunity to recover its just and assimble share of the natural gas in the Eumont Gas Pool.
- (8) That creation of a proration unit consisting of the aforesaid acreage will not cause but will prevent waste, and will protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the application of Sunray Mid-Continent Oil Company for approval of a non-standard provation unit consisting of the following described acreage:

TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM E/2 SE/4 of Section 11 and W/2 SW/4 of Section 12

be and the same is hereby approved, and a proration unit consisting of aforesaid acreage is hereby created.

(2) That applicant's well, C. W. Marshall Well No. 2, located in the NE/4 SE/4 of Section II, Township 2I South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, shall be granted an allowable in the preportion that the above described 160 acre unit bears to the standard or orthodox prevation unit for said pool, all until further order of the Commission.




