Shaft No. 3 located in Section 13, Township 20 South, Range 30 East, was completed in 1954. Mining will be done in all directions radiating from No. 3 shaft.

Commercial beds of potassium chloride underlie the remaining acreage embraced in leases as described above. Some mining in these beds has been done from Shaft No. 2. Within the next ten years mining will be in progress under a substantial part of the lease block described above.

It is imperative that this lease block be transferred to "A" status to insure economic recovery and operation of these potash reserves.




