Dear Sir:

After Preliminary discussion with Mr. Reider and upon his recommendations we wish to submit for approval, a request for an examiner type hearing to be held in Hobbs at the earliest convenience of the commission.

We refer you to NE SE Sec 33-17-33, Lea County, New Mexico. Barney Cockburn, Oil Operator, has two wells on one 40 acre tract. The Cockburn Federal # 1 is a Corbin Queen well drilled in 1950 and the Cockburn Federal # 7 is completed in another sand 130' above the Corbin Queen. We would like to show by evidence of bottom hole pressure communication tests and gamma ray-neutron logs that each of these wells are producing from a separate and independent reservoir. We would like to establish a new pool to be known as the PT Queen sand.

Your cooperation in this matter will be greatly appreciated.

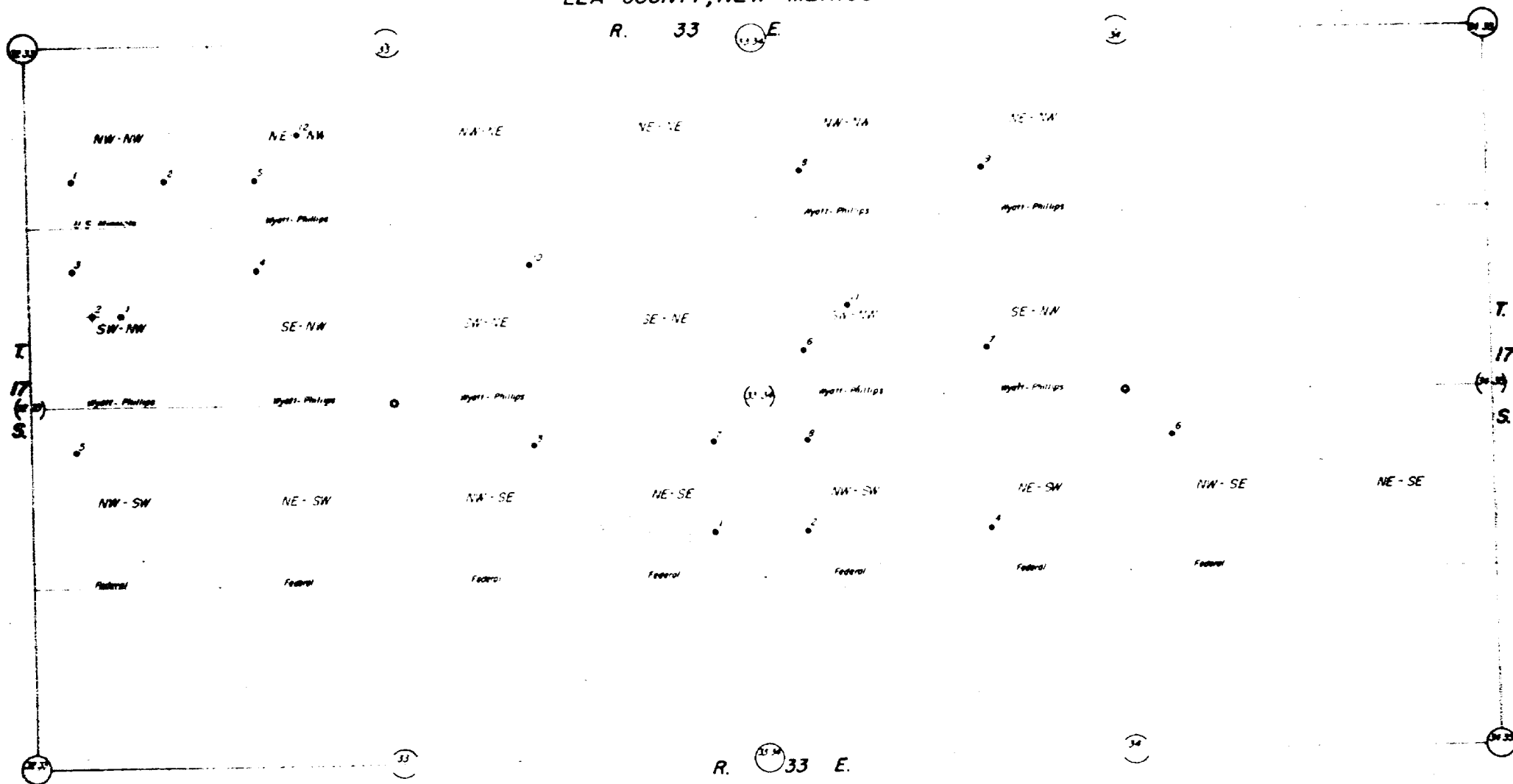



IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:






