

A P P L I C A T I O N

Comes now applicant, Continental Oil Company and respectfully petitions the Commission for an order permitting the dual completion of its Lockhart B-11 well No. 14 to be located 1980 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the East line of Section 11, T21S, R37E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico for production of oil from the Terry Blinebry Oil Pool and for production of gas from the Tubb Gas Pool, and in support thereof would show:

1. Applicant is co-owner and is the operator of a lease designated the A. M. Lockhart B-11 Lease consisting of NW/4 and E/2 Section 11, T21S, R37E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

2. Applicant proposes to drill its A. M. Lockhart B-11 No. 14 well at a location 1980 feet from North and East lines of said Section 11 to an approximate depth of 6350 feet in the Tubb formation and dual complete the well within the vertical limits of the Tubb Gas Pool for gas, and within the vertical limits of the Terry Blinebry Pool, for oil, both as defined in Order No. R-464.

3. Each of the two producing zones will be produced separately by means of a cross-over assembly whereby the Tubb gas zone, being the lowermost zone, will be produced through the tubing-casing annulus and the Terry Blinebry oil zone, being the uppermost zone, will be produced through the tubing. The zones will be adequately separated by means of production packers, one set between the two zones and one set above the uppermost zone.


4. The proposed completion as outlined above is practical and economically feasible, and will not result in the commingling of fluids between oil and gas reservoirs.

5. A plat is attached showing to the best of our knowledge and belief the location of the wells on this lease, the proposed location of the No. 14 well, and the ownership and location of wells on offset leases.

Wherefore, applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing by the Commission examiner at Hobbs, New Mexico, on due notice, and that upon hearing the Oil Conservation Commission enter its order authorizing applicant to dual complete said well in accordance with the foregoing application.
