in support of the subject application, Rowan Oil Company submits the following:

- 1. On September 22, 1955, the Commission granted approval to dually complete the subject well by producing Drinkard oil through the tubing and Blinebry gas through the casing-tubing annulus.
- 2. After encountering many unforeseen problems and incurring exorbitant expenditures, Cary No. 7 was mechanically completed May 27, 1956, as outlined in operator's app cation dated September 9, 1955. (For your convenience a copy of the diagram showing mechanical completion is attached.) However, the Blinebry perforations from 5495-5550' on open flow potential flowed 37 barrels oil, 42.2 gravity, 143,000 C.F.G. in 24 hours on 48/64" choke, 80# C.P., GOR 3864. The Drinkard is producing an average of 5 BOPD as it was before workover.
- 3. Operator made a diligent effort to complete the Blinebry as a gas well although his efforts resulted in oil production from the Blinebry.
- 4. Operator feels it would be impractical to drill and equip a new well to the Blinebry. Due to new techniques developed in dual completion equipment, each zone of a dually completed well can now be efficiently produced. This, coupled with the fact that there is currently an extreme casing shortage, leads the operator to believe that it is far more practical to dually complete its No. 7 Cary well than to drill a twin well.
- 5. The Blinebry oil zone (5495-5550') is currently shut in and would not necessitate additional work to initiate production.

6. Operator feels that producing the Drinkard and Blinebry as an oil-oil dual would be in the interest of conservation and the protection of correlative rights.

7. A copy of this application has been mailed to each offset operator.

Since the operator's conscientious efforts to prudently produce Blinebry gas from the No. 7 Cary well resulted in a flowing oil well, and for the reasons outlined above, Rowan Oil Company respectfully requests the Commission to give this application favorable consideration.
