TRANSCRIPT OF HEARING

MR. PORTER: The last case which will be considered at this time is No. 1199.

(Title of the within case read by Mr. Cooley, attorney for the Oil Commission.)

E L V I S A. U T Z,

called as a witness, testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

By MR. COOLEY

Q State your full name and position for the record..

Elvis A. Utz; Engineer, Oil Conservation Commission.

Q In your official capacity as an Enginner with the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico, have you had an opportunity to make a study of the proposed extension of the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool?

A Yes, I have, and I recommend that the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool be extended as advertised on the basis of two wells capable of producing from this pool.

Q Do you have any recommendation concerning the extension of the Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Pool?

A I recommend that it be extended as advertised on the basis of two wells capable of producing from this well.

Q What are your recommendations concerning the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool?

A I recommend that the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool be extended as advertised on the basis of one well capable of producing from this pool.

Q Do you have any recommendation concerning the Canyon Largo-Pictured Cliffs Pool?

A I recommend that the Canyon-Largo-Pictured Cliffs Pool be extended as advertised on the basis of one well capable of producing from this pool.

Q What is your recommendation concerning the Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool?

A I recommend that the Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool be extended as advertised on the basis of one well capable of producing from this pool.

Q Do you have any recommendation concerning the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool?

A I also recommend that the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool be extended as advertised on the basis of seven wells capable of producing from this pool.

Q Do you have any recommendation concerning the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool?

A I recommend that the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool be extended as advertised on the basis of six wells capable of producing from this pool.

Q What is your recommendation concerning the Blanco Mesaverde Pool?

A I recommend that the Blanco Mesaverde Pool be extended as advertised on the basis of seven wells capable of producing.

Q Do you have any recommendation concerning the creation of an oil pool for Gallup production in Township 31 North, Range 15 West?

A Yes, sir; I recommend that a new pool be created to be known as Gallup Verde Oil Pool.

Q Gallup Verde or Verde Gallup?

A Verde Gallup, I'm sorry.

Q Verde Gallup Oil Pool?

A Verde Gallup Oil Pool.

Q Do you have any further recommendations in this case?

A There are 15 wells included in this pool which are all capable of producing from the Gallup formation. The discovery well for this pool is the C. M. Carroll No. 1 Ute located in Section 14, Township 31 North, Range 15 West. This well had an initial potential of 170 barrels per day natural. The casing shoe is set at 2335. That is all I have with the exception of entering Exhibit No. 1 which states all these extensions and the wells on which they are based.

MR. COOLEY: Will the Commission accept Exhibit 1?

MR. PORTER: Without objection, Exhibit 1 will be admitted. Mr. Utz, I missed the depth of the casing shoe.

MR. PORTER: And I believe you stated there are now 15 wells capable of producing in this area you recommend for the pool?

A That is correct.

MR. MANKIN: What was the unit location of this discovery well?

A I intentionally didn't give it because there is a typo-

graphical error, 615 from the south and 734 from the north--it is not here.

MR. COOLEY: It can be entered later.

MR. PORTER: Anything further? Mr. Utz will be excused and the case taken under advisement. The hearing is adjourned.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on January 16, 1957, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 30th day of January, 1957, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Gallup formation, said pool to bear the designation Verde-Gallup Oil Pool. Said Verde-Gallup Oil Pool was discovered by C. M. Carroll Ute #1, located in the SE/4 SE/4 Section 14, Township 31 North, Range 15 West, NMPM. It was completed September 23, 1955. The depth of the casing shoe is 2,335 feet.

(3) That there is need for certain extensions to the Canyon Largo-Pictured Cliffs Pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, to the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool, the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool, the Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool, and the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool, all in San Juan County, New Mexico, and to the Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Pool, the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool, and the Blanco Mesaverde Pool, all in San Juan and Rio Arriba Counties, New Mexico.
