Rowan Oil Company respectfully submits application for a 160-acre Gas Proration Unit to include all of the N/2 of the S/2 of Section 7, Township 22-S, Range 37-E to be assigned to Rowan Oil Company et al No. 1 H. T. Mattern well in the Arrowhead oil and Eumont gas pools.

It is requested that the Commission set this matter up for Examiner Hearing at an early date. In support of this application, the following facts are offered.

- The above described 160 acres includes the H. T. Mattern lease which 1. consists of the N/2 of the S/2 of Section 7, Township 22-S, Range 37-E. Rowan Oil Company is a joint owner and operator of this lease.
- 2. The proposed unit well is located 330' from the South and West lines of the Mallern lease in Section 7, T-22-S, R-37-E, Lee County, New Mexico, and was completed in October, 1939 in open hole from 3631'-3750' opposite the Grayburg lime.
