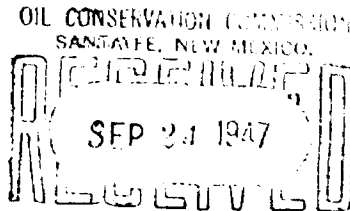




Dear Sir:

As per your request, as to the status of the Tarkington Oil Test,  
located in the center of Section 33 Township 11 South Range 25 East.

The Pecos Valley Artesian Conservancy District's plugging unit  
moved onto this well, August 26, 1946. The New Mexico Glycerin Company of  
Artesia, New Mexico, was employed to shoot this well casing at caprock, the  
depth being 608 feet. They used a 20 quart shot in bursting this casing.

The plugging crew then started pumping mud in this well, until we  
had good mud return, then we pumped in a 25 sack cement plug at this depth  
on September 3, 1946. We moved from this well marking it off of the list of  
wells to be plugged. We consider this well plugged and our records at the  
office are shown as the same.





NOW on the 30 day of July, 1947, the Commission having before it for  
consideration the testimony and evidence adduced at the hearing of said case,  
and being fully advised in the premises;

FINDS:

1. That the Commission has jurisdiction of this proceeding and that due notice was given to all interested parties, as provided by law.
2. That the well involved in this cause is dry and abandoned; that on September 3, 1946, said well was properly plugged by the Pecos Valley Artesian Conservancy District, which plugging meets the requirements of the Commission.
3. That the American Employers Insurance Company is the Surety on the Plugging Bond, and that such bond should now be released by reason of the proper plugging of said well.
4. That no further proceedings are necessary to finally dispose of this cause;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The plugging bond filed with the Commission in connection with the drilling of the well involved in this cause, located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 33, Township 11 South, Range 25 East, N.M.P.M. be and it is hereby released.
