FINDS that the Petitioners should be permitted to deepen an unorthodox location 220 feet from the East line and 880 feet from the North line of Section 32, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, as prayed by their petition herein; that said deepening will tend to promote the conservation of oil and gas and the prevention of waste.

### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

SECTION 1. That the application of Malco Refineries, Inc., Dale Resler d/b/a Resler Oil Company, and Martin Yates, Inc. for approval of the deepening of an unorthodox location 220 feet from the East line and 880 feet from the North line of Section 32, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, to a depth of 2900 feet be and it is hereby granted.

SECTION 2. That this Commission reserves jurisdiction for the purpose of making any further orders or requirements that may appear to be proper in the premises from time to time.
