ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 10:00 o'clock A.M., February 17, 1948, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this the 10 day of ^{March} February, 1948, the Commission having before it for consideration the testimony and other evidence adduced at the hearing of said case and the application of petitioners and being fully advised in the premises:

FINDS that the Petitioners should be permitted to deepen an unorthodox location 220 feet from the East line and 880 feet from the North line of Section 32, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, as prayed by their petition herein; that said deepening will tend to promote the conservation of oil and gas and the prevention of waste.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

SECTION 1. That the application of Malco Refineries, Inc., Dale Resler d/b/a Resler Oil Company, and Martin Yates, Jr. for approval of the deepening of an unorthodox location 220 feet from the East line and 880 feet from the North line of Section 32, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, to a depth of 2900 feet be and it is hereby granted.

SECTION 2. That this Commission reserves jurisdiction for the purpose of making any further orders or requirements that may appear to be proper in the premises from time to time.

TO THE HONORABLE OIL COMBINATION COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF
NEW MEXICO:

The Petitioners herein, appearing by their attorney,
Donald S. Bush of Artesia, New Mexico, hereby make application
for an order approving the deepening of an unorthodox location,
located 220 feet from the East line and 340 feet from the North
line of Section 32, Township 16 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M.,
Eddy County, New Mexico; said locations being closer to the
boundary lines of the units involved than is permitted by general
rules and regulations, and in support thereof respectfully state
as follows:

1. That said unorthodox location, known as the Flynn,
Welch, and Yates State No. 28 Well, was previously completed to a
total depth of approximately 2039 feet, on or about the 28th day
of September, 1935, prior to the enactment of the Oil and Gas
Conservation laws of the State of New Mexico.

2. That the unit on which said well is drilled is a
part of Unit No. 1, known as No. 17, title to which,
by subsequent assignment, has been located in Palco Refineries,
Incorporated, Dale Reseler &/b/a Reseler Oil Company, and Martin
Yates Jr., as co-owners.


3. That said well was drilled to deepen said unortho-
dox location to a depth of 2200 feet for the reason
that the present depth of said well is not sufficient to
economically produce oil. By deepening said well,
greater production of oil will be obtained from the unit.

information necessary to determine the feasibility of drilling said acreage to said lower depth.

4. That the owner of the forty acre unit, immediately adjacent on the East of the unit affected by this Petition, makes no objections to the requests contained herein, as shown by the Waiver, hereto attached, marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof.

In consideration of the foregoing statements, your Petitioners respectfully request that the Commission give notice as required by the rules and regulations of the Commission; that a hearing on this matter be held; that the Petitioners be permitted to offer proof of the facts herein stated, and that the Commission make the following finding and order, to wit:

A. That the Commission execute an order authorizing your Petitioners to deepen the unorthodox location as herein stated.

The Petitioners herein, appearing by their attorney, Donald S. Nash of Aricoma, New Mexico, hereby make application for an order approving the deepening of an unorthodox location, located 220 feet from the East line and 833 feet from the North line of Section 32, Township 13 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M., Siskiyou County, New Mexico; said locations being closer to the boundary lines of the units involved than is permitted by general rules and regulations, and in support thereof respectfully state as follows:

2. That the unit on which said well was drilled is a part of that certain oil and gas lease No. 647, title to which, by subsequent assignments, has been lodged in Hanco Refineries, Incorporated, of Lesler & 1/2 Lesler Oil Company, and Martin Yates Jr., as co-owners.

4. That the owner of the lot, lot 11, and lot 12, adjacent on the west side of the said street, have no objections to the proposed widening herein, to the use of the street, hereinafter described, and that the said lot 11 and lot 12 are not needed.
