ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 10:00 o'clock A.M., February 17, 1948, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this the 12 day of ^{March} February, 1948, the Commission having before it for consideration the testimony and other evidence adduced at the hearing of said case and the application of petitioners and being fully advised in the premises:

FINDS that the Petitioners should be permitted to deepen an unorthodox location to be located 1070 feet from the South Line and 1070 feet from the East line of Section 27, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, as prayed by their petition herein; that said deepening will tend to promote the conservation of oil and gas and the prevention of waste.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

SECTION 1. That the application of Dale Resler d/b/a Resler Oil Company for approval of the deepening of an unorthodox location to be located 1070 feet from the South line and 1070 feet from the East line of Section 27, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, to a depth of 2900 feet be and it is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. That this Commission reserves jurisdiction for the purpose of making any further orders or requirements that may appear to be proper in the premises from time to time.

The Petitioner herein, appearing by his attorney,
Donald S. Bush of Artesia, New Mexico, hereby makes application
for the approval of the deepening of an unorthodox location to
be located 1070 feet from the South line and 1070 feet from the
East line of Section 27, Township 18 South, Range 28 East,
N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico. Said location being closer to
the boundary lines of the units involved than is permitted by
general rules and regulations, and in support thereof respectfully
states as follows:

1. That said location was known as the Guillen-Dunnett
Compton No. 1 Well, and was completed at a total depth of 2505
feet on or about the 28th day of August, 1926, prior to the
enactment of the Oil and Gas Conservation laws of the State of
New Mexico, and that your Petitioner desires to deepen said well
to an approximate depth of 3000 feet.

2. That the unit in which said well was drilled is a
part of the Oil and Gas Lease No. 647, et al., by subsequent
action, and that this 40 acre unit has been located in Unit
No. 1/2/1 under Oil Company.


3. That said well is now known as the Resler Compton

4. That Petitioner desires to drill said well to the

TO THE HONORABLE OIL AND GAS COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

The Petitioner herein, appearing by his attorney, Donald S. Bush of Artesia, New Mexico, hereby makes application for the approval of the deepening of an unorthodox location to be located 1070 feet from the South line and 1070 feet from the East line of Section 27, Township 13 South, Range 2 East, N.M.P.M., Sandoz County, New Mexico. Said location being closer to the boundary lines of the units involved than is permitted by general rules and regulations, and in support thereof respectfully states as follows:

1. That said location was known as the Guillen-Mannett Soughton No. 1 Well, and was completed at a total depth of 2505 feet on or about the 28th day of August, 1926, prior to the enactment of the Oil and Gas Conservation laws of the State of New Mexico, and that your petitioner desires to deepen said well to an approximate depth of 3000 feet.

2. That the unit on which said well was drilled is a part of State Oil and Gas Lease No. 647, and that, by subsequent assignments, title to this 40 acre unit has been lodged in Dale Resler d/b/a Resler Oil Company.

3. That said well is now known as the Shannon State No. 1 Well.

4. That petitioner desires to drill said well to the deeper depth for the reason that said well was a dry hole and that by deepening said well, your petitioner can more economically obtain the geological information necessary to determine the feasibility of drilling said acreage to said lower depth.

In consideration of the foregoing statements, your Petitioner respectfully requests that the Commission give notice as required by the rules and regulations of the Commission; that a hearing on this matter be held; that the petitioner be permitted to offer proof of the facts herein stated; and that the Commission make the following findings and order, to wit:

1. That the request for deepening of the unorthodox location as herein set forth is approved; that no other measures of oil and gas be required.
