N.M.P.M., LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO AND TO INCLUDE
SAID DESCRIBED LAND IN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE
EXISTING REDEFINED POOL IN SAID COUNTY.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter came on regularly for hearing at 10:00 o'clock A.M., April 22, 1948, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 3rd day of May, 1948, the Commission having before it for consideration the testimony adduced at the hearing of said cause and being fully advised in the premises;

FINDS:

1. That proper public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause;

2. That there has been no objection to the recommendation of the New Mexico Nomenclature Committee as submitted to the Commission and there being none by the Commission;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1, S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 2, S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 3, N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 10, all of Section 11, and the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 12 in Township 17 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, be and the same hereby is deleted from the West Roberts Pool, and said described lands are hereby added to as a part of the Roberts Pool and the description of lands included in said Roberts Pool in Commission's Order No. 633 is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Township 17 South, Range 32 East, Lea County, New Mexico

S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 1
S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 2
S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 3
N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 10
All of Section 11
N $\frac{1}{2}$ and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12;

Township 17 South, Range 33 East, Lea County, New Mexico

S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 6,
N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 7;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the term "West Roberts Pool" is nonessential for proration or other purposes.

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico on the day and year hereinabove designated.
