The corporate surety and petitioner has brought a proceeding before this Commission for a determination of the well as abandoned and for an order to plug said well. If the petitioner is successful in obtaining, after hearing, the finding of fact of abandement and an order authorizing plugging, then the Commission will require a plugging program to be carried out in keeping with conservation standards for the protection of undesired mater encroachments, but whatever disposition is made of the casing or equipment is a matter over which the Commission has no jurisdiction and is a matter between the actual owners and whoever endeavors to dispose of such property. Possibly the surety and petitioner has or will investigate the ownership of any easing or other property in the hole.
