## ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

### BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9:00 o'clock a.m. on July 15, 1959, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW on this Aday of July, 1959, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises.

#### FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

  - Yes sir, I have.
- What are your recommendations concerning the extension of the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool?
- I recommend that the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool be extend as shown on Paragraph A of Exhibit Number 1 on the basis of two wells completed in this pool.
- What are your recommendations concerning the extension of the Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Pool?
- I recommend that the Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Pool be extended as shown on Paragraph B of Exhibit 1 based upon one well completed in this pool.
- Do you recommend that the extension shown on Paragraph C of Exhibit 1 be dismissed?
  - Yes sir, I recommend that Paragraph C be dismissed
