Inasmuch as our obligation to prevent the physical waste of oil and gas is paramount, we do not feel that further extensions of time in which to make beneficial use of casinghead gas in Bisti and Gallegos are warranted.

When wells which have been shut-in due to lack of a casinghead gas connection are connected, the 125% daily tolerance provision will be waived during the month in which the connection is made if necessary.

We again remind all operators that as soon as well connections are obtained, the Aztec office of the Oil Conservation Commission must be so notified."



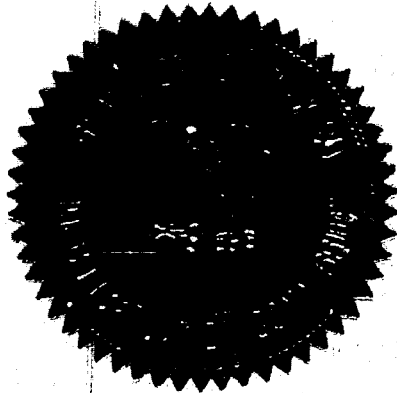
