MR. PORTER: Next case on the docket, 2121, Northwestern New Mexico nomenclature case.

(Witness sworn.)

A. R. KENDRICK

a witness, called by and on behalf of the Oil Conservation Commission, was duly sworn, and testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

BY MR. PAYNE:

- Will the witness please state his name and position?
- Α A. R. Kendrick, Engineer, Oil Commission.
- Have you made a study concerning the necessity or desirability of creating a new pool or extending existing pools in San Juan and Rio Arriba Counties, New Mexico?



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I have.

What are your recommendations concerning the creation of Q a new pool for Gallup production?

I recommend that a new pool be created in San Juan County for the production of oil from the Gallup formation, known as the Kutz-Gallup Oil Pool, based on a discovery well, El Paso Natural Gas Products Company No. 1, Frontier "B" located in Unit P of 9, 27 North, 11 West; initial potential 30 barrels of oil per day; completed April 11, 1958, top perforation 5818 feet, vertical limits of this pool to be the Gallup formation; horizontal limits as shown on the docket for this case. There are fourteen other wells produc ing in the area identified on the docket.

What are your recommendations concerning the extension of the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool?

That the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool be extended as shown in Paragraph B of Exhibit 1, on the basis of three wells completed therein.

What are your recommendations concerning extension of the Otero-Chacra Pool?

That the pool be extended as shown in Paragraph C of Exhibit 1 on the basis of one well completed therein.

What are your recommendations concerning the extension of the Cha Cha-Gallup Oil Pool?

That the Cha-Gallup Oil Pool be extended as shown in Paragraph D of Exhibit 1, which includes acreage not shown on the



docket as follows: Township 29 North, Range 14 West, Section 21, Northeast 1/4; Section 26, Northeast 1/4, based on 16 wells completed therein.

- What are your recommendations concerning extension of the Devils Fork-Gallup Pool?
- That it be extended as shown in Paragraph E of Exhibit 1, on the basis of one well completed therein.
- What are your recommendations concerning the Verde-Gallup Oil Pool?
- That it be extended as shown in Paragraph F of Exhibit 1, Α on the basis of two wells completed therein.
- MR. PAYNE: I move the introduction of Exhibit Number 1 in Case 2121.
