A P P L I C A T I O N

Applicant states:

1. That it is the owner and operator of its Capps Federal No. 1 located 1980 feet from the East line and 1980 feet from the South line of Section 13, Township 9 South, Range 35 East, Lea County, which is a depleted oil well and now shutin.
2. That applicant proposes to use said well as a disposal well for injection of salt water into the Pennsylvanian-Bough "C" Section, which well will be an expansion of the Bough Pool Salt Water Disposal System.
3. That the granting of this application will not cause waste nor impair the correlative rights of any party.

WHEREFORE applicant prays that this application be set for hearing, that notice thereof be given as required by law and that upon the evidence adduced at such hearing this Commission issue an order granting applicant authority to inject salt water into the Pennsylvanian-Bough "C" Section as herein requested and such other relief as this Commission may deem necessary and proper.

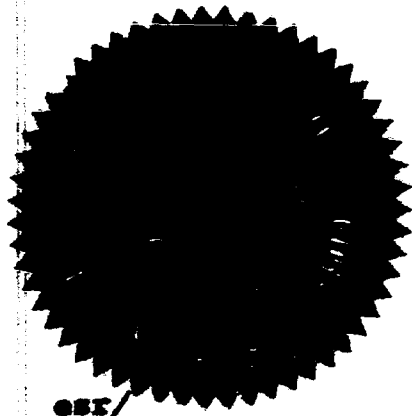
