Dear Sir:

This refers to the telephone conversation between Mr. Dan Nother and Mr. John Queen of this office in regard to Case 2185, Section 0 to extend the North Mason Delaware Pool to include SE/4 of Section 30, T26S, R32E. This extension was to include Continental Oil Company's Russell Federal 30 No. 1, a recent completion in the Delaware Sand. Since there is a dry hole between the North Mason producing wells and the subject well, it is recommended that Section 0 of Case 2185 be postponed pending additional study.

It is Continental's opinion, at the present time, that the Russell Federal 30 No. 1 is producing from a separate reservoir than the North Mason Pool, however, additional drilling will be required to justify this point. Due to the present producing rate of the subject well, Continental does not propose additional development at the present time. At such time as we are able to justify an additional well which is expected within the next six months, we will be happy to further discuss this matter.

#### ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

## BY THE CONCLESION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on Pehrwary 15, 1961, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 17th day of February, 1961, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises.

TIMPS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Les County, New Mexico. for the production of oil from the Welfcomp formation, said pool to hear the designation South Dunken-Welfermy Pool. Said South Deston-Welfermy Pool was discovered by Socony Mebil Oil Company, Inc., New Mexico "M" Well No. 1, located in the SW/4 of Section 36, Township 15 South, Range 37 Net, MMFM. It was completed November 21, 1960. The top of performations is at 2400 foot.

(3) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Hddy County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Paddock formation, said pool to bear the designation Empire-Paddock Pool. ### BY THE CONFLISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on February 15, 1961, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NON, on this \_\_\_\_\_\_ day of February 1961, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

#### FINDS:
