(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.


(2) That the applicant, Pan American Petroleum Corporation, has requested that Case No. 2448 be dismissed.

New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Case 2448 is the application of Pan American Petroleum Corporation for approval of a pressure maintenance program on several of its leases in the Cha Cha-Gallup Oil Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. This case was originally scheduled for hearing November 29, 1961, but was continued to the January 4, 1962, Examiner Docket.

Accelerated progress in the formation of a unit in the southeast portion of this pool has recently occurred. Because of this progress we are extremely hopeful that in the immediate future a hearing will be requested for approval of a unit and waterflood plans for conducting a unitized pressure maintenance program in the southeastern portion of the Cha Cha-Gallup Oil Pool. 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


