THE APPLICATION OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION UPON ITS OWN MOTION FOR AN ORDER <u>RENAMING, CLEATING, ABOLISHING,</u> <u>AND EXTENDING CERTAIN</u> <u>POOLS IN LEA EDDY,</u> <u>AND CHAVES COUNTIES,</u> <u>NEW MEXICO.</u>

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on <u>February 14,1963</u> at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That there is need for the renaming of the Vacuum-Abo Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Abo production, to the Vactuum-Abo Reef Pool with the vertical limits of said pool changed from the entire Abo formation to the Abo Reef formation and the horizontal limits remaining unchanged. This change is necessary to correct for geologic nomenclature.

(3) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Bone Spring formation, said gool to bear the designation of Green wood - Bone Spring Tool. Said Greenwood - Bane Spring Pool was discovered by Pan American Petroleum Corporation, Greenwood Unit Well No.7, located in Unit H of Section 12, Township 19 South, Range 31 East, NMPM.
