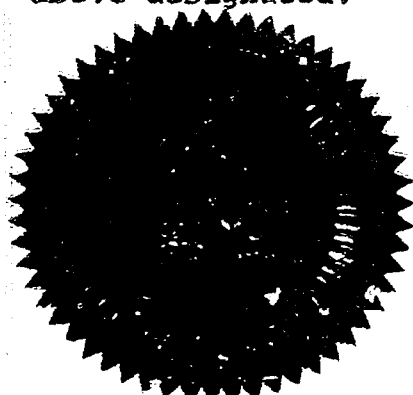





that are located on these locations, and I have had a conference with Mr. Oscar Jordan, the attorney for the State Land Office, since this case was docketed and as a result of that conference we have determined that the State Land Office has primary jurisdiction in this matter; and I would like to move to dismiss this case at this time, and it will be turned over to the State Land Office if the motion is granted, for whatever procedure they would feel would be appropriate under the circumstances, since this is a State lease.

MR. UTZ: Failure to fill pits is still a failure to follow Commission rules.

MR. DURRETT: There's a question about that. That's the reason I want to turn it to the State Land Office. The only requirement we have in the rules is that pits must be filled before a C-103 plugging form can be approved and there can't be any plugging form approved until the wells have been drilled. There are no wells drilled. They are just locations staked and pits dug. We feel it would be appropriate to turn it to the State Land Office and on that basis I would move to dismiss the case.

MR. UTZ: Case 2816 will be dismissed.
