Gentlemen:

Attached are zone segregation tests, bottom hole pressure tests, diagrammatic sketch of completion installation and acoustilog for the subject well reflecting dual completion status of the well in the Vacuum North Abo and Vacuum Wolfcamp Pools.

The well was originally planned as a triple completion (combination tubingless and conventional) in the Devonian, Wolfcamp and Abo, with 4-1/2" casing and 2-3/8" tubing to the Devonian and parallel strings of 2-7/8" casing to the Abo and Wolfcamp. Administrative Order No. MC-1292 dated April 15, 1963 was issued approving the installation. Subsequently a letter dated April 19, 1963 was submitted to the Commission requesting approval to substitute 3-1/2" casing and 1-1/2" tubing for the Devonian completion in lieu of the aforementioned 4-1/2" casing and 1-1/2" tubing.

The Devonian formation was encountered low on structure and proved non-productive. The Devonian was plugged off and an attempt at completing the Morrow zone was made in the 3-1/2" casing. This zone was proven non-productive and the 3-1/2" casing - 1-1/2" tubing string was shut in, held for possible recompletion in the Blinberry at a later date if results of development in the area indicates it to be advisable.

It is respectfully requested that approval of the dual completion be granted in accord with the facts outlined above. It is understood that since Devonian completions in the Vacuum are the only zones in which the Commission has approved 3-1/2" casing - 1-1/2" tubing strings, if the subject



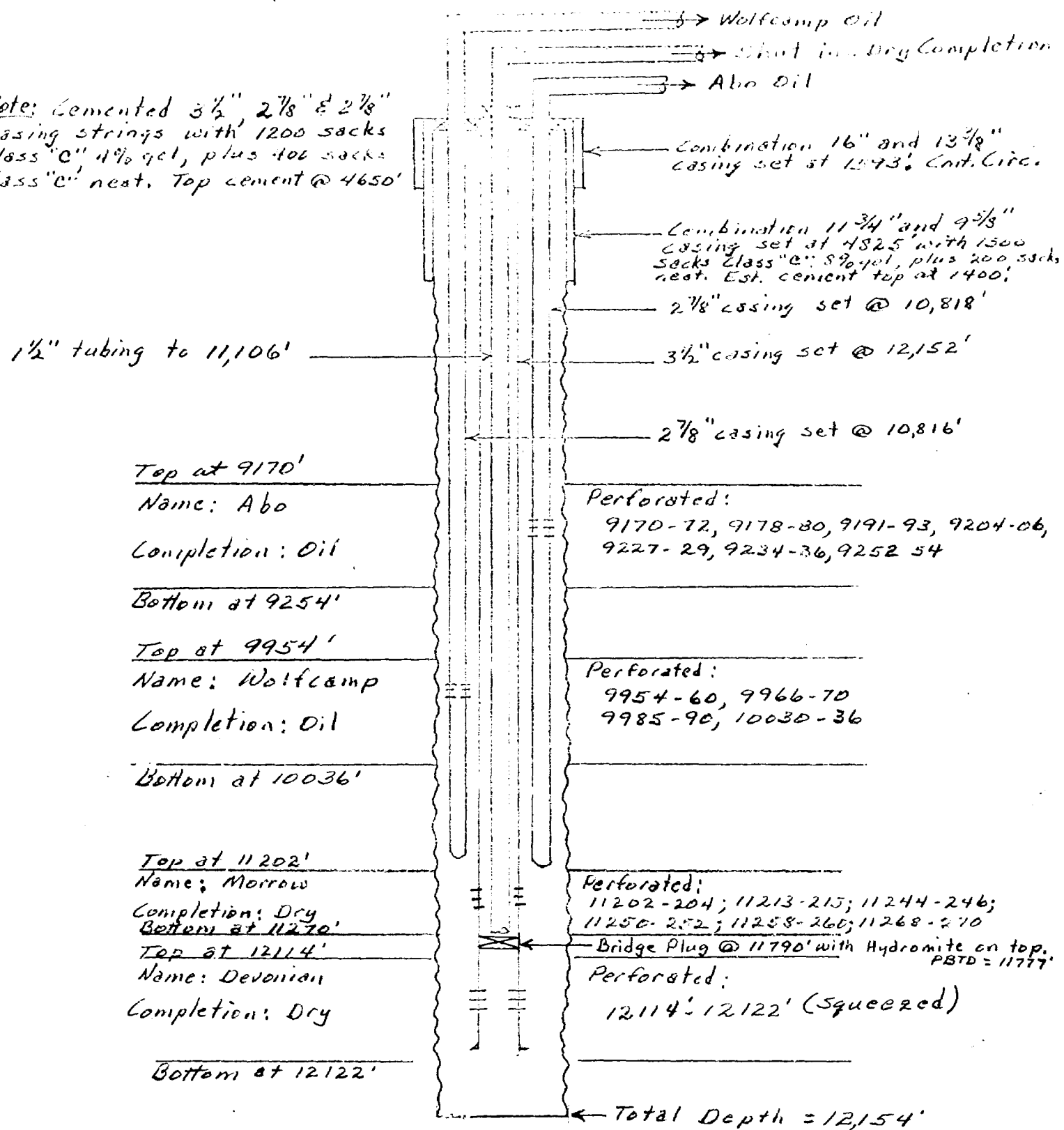

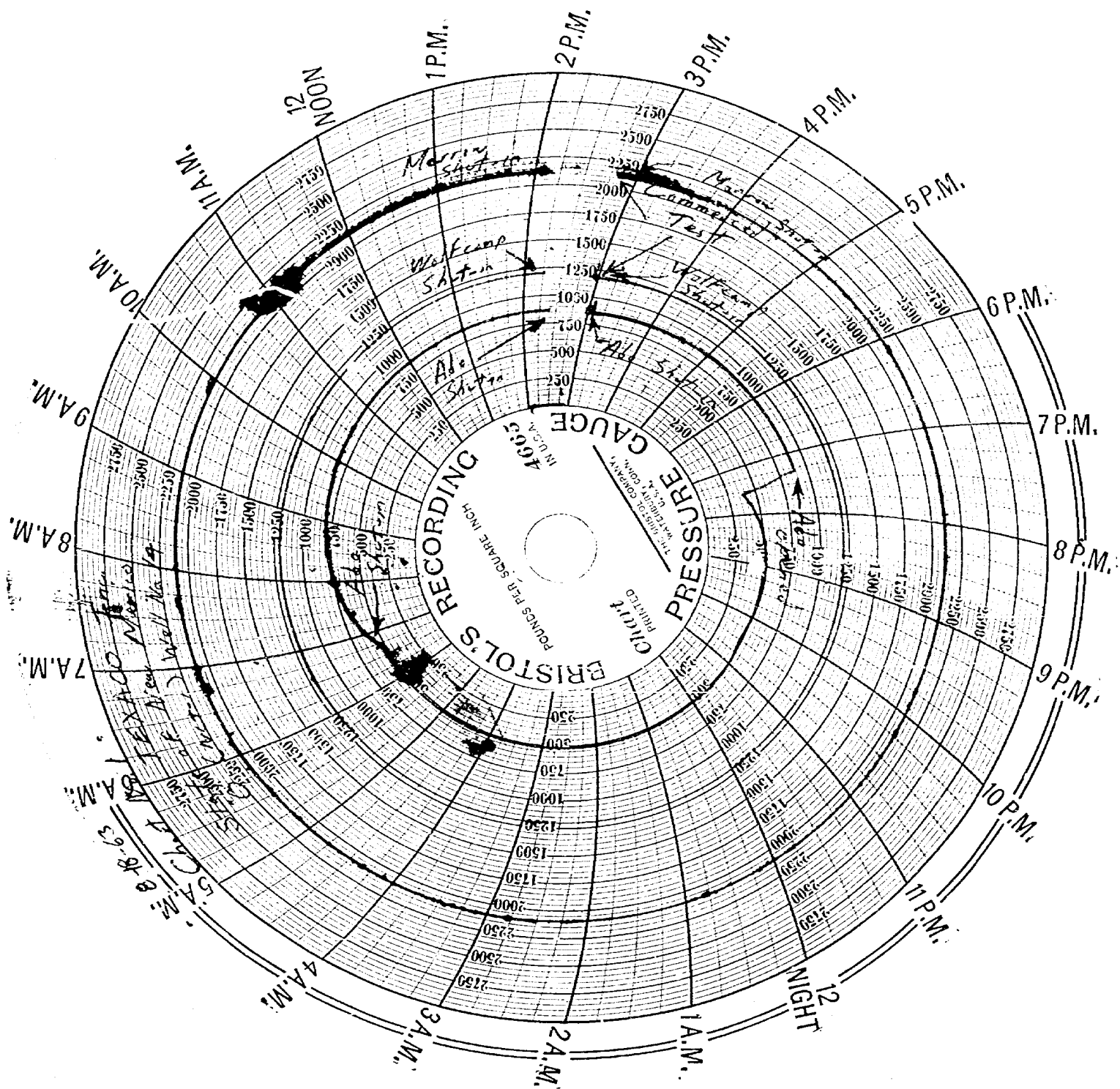
DIAGRAMMATIC SKETCH OF MULTIPLE COMPLETION INSTALLATION

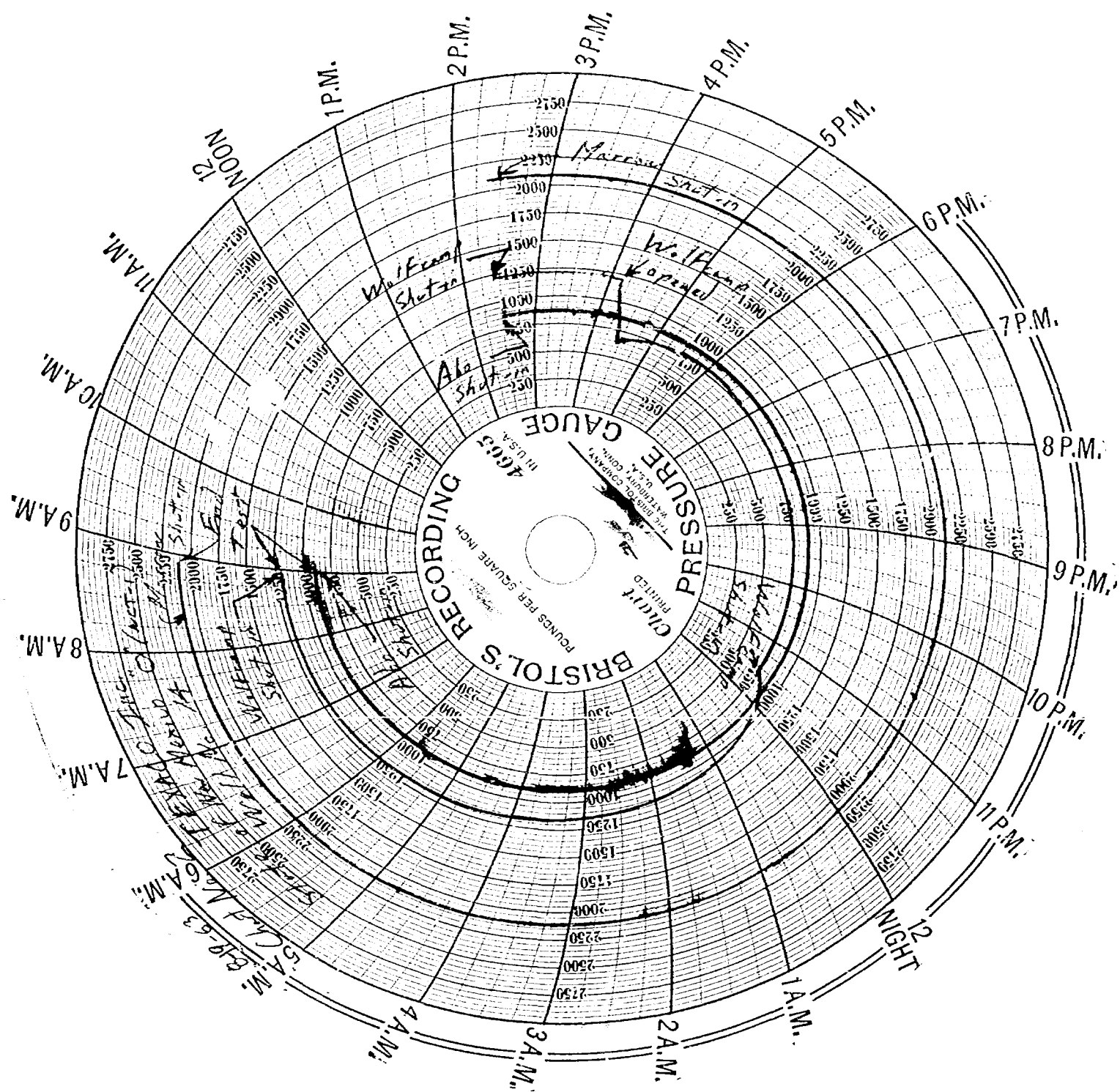

Gentlemen:

TEXACO Inc. respectfully requests revisions to the casing and cementing program proposed in Application for Triple Completion, TEXACO Inc., State of New Mexico "O" (NCT-1) Well No. 14, Lea County, New Mexico, dated February 15, 1963. The requested change is to use 3-1/2 inch casing and 1-1/2 inch tubing in place of 4-1/2 inch casing and 2-3/8 inch tubing for producing the Devonian and to set the 2-7/8 inch Abo casing string at approximately 10,800 feet instead of at 10,000 feet. The 2-7/8 inch Wolfcamp casing string is to be set at 10,800 feet as initially proposed. Instead of cementing down 4-1/2 inch casing only and using a two-stage cementing tool, TEXACO Inc. desires to cement down the 3-1/2 inch casing with 400 sacks of Incor neat cement for the first stage and down both 2-7/8 inch casing strings with 1750 sacks of Incor cement with 4% gel for the second stage. *MC-1282*

A favorable reply to this request shall be appreciated. A revised diagrammatic sketch is attached and a copy of this requested revision is being sent to each offset operator on this date by registered mail.

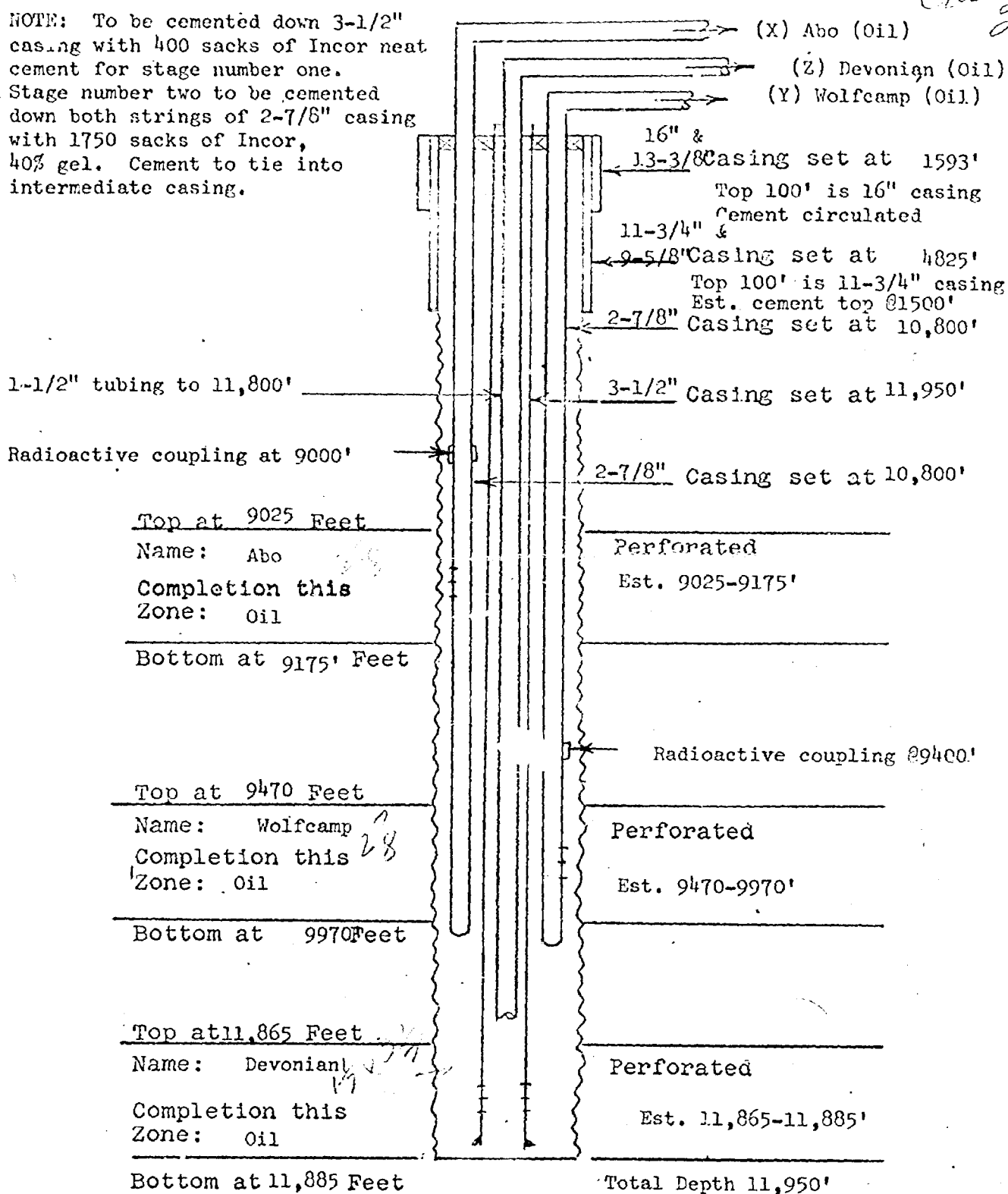
