





MR. DURRETT: Application of El Paso Natural Gas Company for three non-standard gas proration units and one unorthodox well location, San Juan County, New Mexico.

MR. WHITWORTH: Garrett Whitworth, member of the Texas Bar, for El Paso Natural Gas Company; and I think that Mr. Richard Morris has made an appearance in this case.

MR. UT7: Yes, he has.

MR. WHITWORTH: We have one witness to be sworn, Mr. Gerald Hickson.

(Witness sworn.)

GERALD HICKSON

called as a witness, having been first duly sworn, was examined and testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

BY MR. WHITWORTH:

- Mr. Hickson, for the record, would you please state your name, by whom and in what capacity you are employed?
- Gerald Hickson, employed by El Paso Natural Gas Company Α as a proration engineer.
- Have you previously testified as an expert proration engineer before this Commission?
 - Α Yes, sir.
 - Q. Have your qualifications been made a matter of record?



DEARNLEY-MEIER REPORTING SERVICE, Inc.

- Α They have.
- Q To your knowledge, they haven't changed since that time?
- No.

MR. UTZ: The witness' qualifications are acceptable.

(By Mr. Whitworth) Mr. Hickson, by this application, what does El Paso seek to do in this case?

We're seeking approval of three non-standard proration units, one being 376.88 acres, comprising the Southeast Quarter and the East Half of the Southwest Quarter and Lots 1, 2 and 3 of Section 9, and Lots 3 and 4 and the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 10, 32 and 7; one unit being 357.84 acres, being the Southeast Quarter, the South Half of the Southwest Quarter, and the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter and Lots 1 and 2 of Section 10, and Lots 3 and 4 of Section 11, 32 and 7; the third unit being 359.2 acres, the South Half and Lots 1 and 2 of Section 11, all in Township 32 and 7.

Does El Paso also seek approval of an unorthodox location for a well to be drilled in the Southeast Quarter of Section 9?

- Yes, sir.
- Do you have a plat depicting the exact location of these proposed non-standard units and also the proposed location of this unorthodox well?
 - Α Yes, sir, I do. It's El Paso's Exhibit No. 1.



(Whereupon, El Paso's Exhibit No. 1 marked for identification.)

- Would you please explain this exhibit, Mr. Hickson?
- The units outlined in red are Basin Dakota non-standard proration units as set out in Order R-2046. The units in yellow are units which have previously been established as Mesaverde non-standard proration units to conform with the Basin Dakota units in 2046.

The three units in green are the three non-standard proration units which we are asking for approval of here today, and the well located in Section 9, the Southeast Quarter of Section 9 is our unorthodox location.

- Why is it necessary to have a hearing on these proposed non-standard units?
- Well, sir, in Section 9 the non-standard unit we're requesting crosses a governmental section, and the same in Section 10, and 11 is greater than 320 acres.
- Q To your knowledge, have there been any applications previously granted to non-standard units in this area?
- Α Yes, sir, in the Mesaverde there has been three in the 32,7 Unit and one in the Allison Unit in Section 12.
- 0 All of these proposed non-standard units are located in the Allison Unit, is that right?
 - Α Yes, sir, that's correct.
 - Who is the operator of that unit? Q



- Are there any offset operators to these proposed non-El Paso Natural Gas Company.

Only the 32, 7 Unit and El Paso operates that and has Q standard units?

Why is it necessary, Mr. Hickson, to have a hearing on no objection to this application.

Well, Rule 2 of Section 8, special rules for the Blanco this proposed unorthodox well location? Mesaverde Pool of Order R-1670, state that a standard location shall be located in the Northeast Quarter or Southwest Quarter

Well, in Section 9 of 32 and 7, there is already one of a governmental section. standard location which is in the 32, 7 Unit. In order to set up a better drainage pattern for the area in the Mesaverde and Dakota, we have moved this location to the Southeast Quarter.

Why is the well located exactly where it is depicted on

Well, that location was set out by our geological department in order to have a more effective drainage area in the plat? this area in both the Mesavarde and Dakota. Had we put it in a standard location in Section 9, we would have had two wells in Mr. Hickson, at the proper time, administrative approval the Southwest Quarter of Section 9.

We have, in Section 24 of Α 32 and 7 in Colorado we have a Mesaverde Dakota dual, and one in Section 9 of 32 and 7, which is in 32,7 Unit; and in Section 16 it's a Mesaverde single, and this would set up a better drainage pattern in both zones if we drill the well in the Southeast Quarter rather than in the standard location, being in the Southwest Quarter.

It might even prevent the No. 19 from draining some Q New Mexico gas?

Α Yes, sir.


