I have received virtually no C-104's or C-122 for wells in the Indian Basin area and therefore, have had no official records from which to prepare an ad. DIRECT EXAMINATION

BY MR. DURRETT:

- Q Please state your name and position for the record.
- A Daniel S. Nutter, Chief Engineer for the Oil Conservation Commission.
- Q Mr. Nutter, are you prepared to make recommendations to the Commission this morning concerning the creation, contraction, extension and abolishment of certain pools in Eddy, Lea and Roosevelt Counties, New Mexico.
 - A Yes, I am.
- Q And are you prepared to make recommendations in the form of an exhibit?
 - A Yes, sir.
 - Q How is that marked?
 - A It is identified as Exhibit "A" in this case.
- Q Exhibit "A" similar to the docket that's been prepared and distributed here?
 - A Yes, sir, it is, with certain exceptions.
- Q Would you please refer to your exhibit and to the docket generally distributed here this morning and point out

your recommendations to the Commission?

A All right, sir. (indicating) In paragraph "A" of Case 3054, I recommend that the Bough-San Andres be created comprising the southwest quarter of Section 13, Township 9 South, Range 35 East. The pool was discovered by Pan American Federal A Number 1, and is located in Unit NF Section 13, completed in the San Andres January 18, 1964, at that time perforations at 4746.

Paragraph "B", I would recommend that the Lovington-Queen Gas Pool be created comprising the southeast quarter of Section 14, Township 17 South, Range 36 East, Lea County; the pool was discovered by Sun Ray DX State AL Number 1 in Unit I of Section 14, completed in the Queen August 13, 1963, top perforation 4300 feet.

Middle Pennsylvanian Pool be created comprising the west half of Section 10 which is additional acreage other than shown in the docket. That would be the west half of Section 10, Township 11 South, Range 33 East. The pool was discovered by Texas Pacific J. P. Collier Number 1 located in Unit F of Section 10, completed in the Middle Pennsylvanian Pool, May 16, 1964, the top of the perforation is 9762 feet. I would recommend that special vertical lengths be assigned to this pool being from the minus



5397 feet subsea to minus 5727 subsea in the type log of the Texas Pacific Oil Company's J. P. Collier Well Number 1 in Unit F of Section 10.

In paragraph "D", I would recommend that the vertical limits of the North Bagley-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool be contracted. The pool presently has vertical lengths in the Pennsylvanian formation. I would recommend that this be contracted to read and be defined as from minus 4783 feet subsea to a minus 5397 feet subsea; the type log would be the Texas Pacific Oil Company's J. P. Collier Well Number 1, Township 11 South, Range 33 East.

In paragraph "E", I would recommend that a new pool be created and designated the South Prairie Atoka Gas Pool, comprising the southwest quarter of Section 21, Township 8 South, Range 36 East, Roosevelt County. The pool was discovered by Lone Star as Federal New Mexico B, Unit M, Sectuin 21 created Atoka February 10, 1946. The top perforation 12,057 feet.

In paragraph "F", I would recommend that the vertical limits at South Prairie Pennsylvanian Pool be contracted and the name changed from the South Prairie Pennsylvanian



Pool to South Prairie Cisco Pool. The vertical limits would be the Cisco Zone of the Pennsylvanian formation.

- Q That's not Cisco, that's Colorado.
- A The longer range is called Cisco.

In paragraph "G", I would recommend the North Benson Queen-Grayburg Pool be extended as shown on the exhibit and on the docket.

In paragraph "H", I would recommend that the Flying
"M"-San Andres Pool be extended as follows; which differs
from the docket: I'd also recommend next time that the
exhibit be made in the same order that the same cases
appear.

- Q Which paragraph are you on?
- A I think I'm on "H".
- ο "H"?

A In "H", I would recommend the Flying "M"-San
Andres Pool be extended through the east half of Section
16, Northeast quarter of Section 21, southwest quarter of
Section 16, all in Township 9 South, Range 33 East.

In paragraph "I", I would recommend the Justis Blinebry Pool be extended as shown on Exhibit "A" and docket.

In paragraph "J", I would recommend that the Lusk-Strawn Pool be extended to include the west half of Section 25, Township 19 South, Range 32 East in the northwest

quarter of Section 25 and the southeast quarter of Section 25, Township 19 South, Range 31 East.

Paragraph "K", I would recommend that the Maljamar Pool be extended as shown on Exhibit "A", being the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 36, Township 17 South, Range 31 East.

Paragraph "L", I would recommend the Mescalero-San Andres Pool be extended as shown on the docket and exhibit.

Paragraph "M", I would recommend the East Millman Queen-Grayburg Pool be extended as shown on the docket and exhibit.

Paragraph "N", I would recommend the Pearl Queen Pool be extended as shown on the docket and exhibit.

Paragraph "O", I would recommend that the Vacuum-Abo Reef Pool be extended to include the south half of the southwest quarter of Section 2, Township 18 South, Range 34 East.

MR. PORTER: South half of the southwest quarter.

A Of Township 18, 34, the Township west quarter of Section 8, Township 18, 35 and in Township 17 South, Range 36 East, I would recommend that the extension be less than that shown on the docket and would comprise



the west half of the southwest quarter and the southwest, quarter, northwest quarter of Section 19, Township 17 South, Range 36 East rather than the entire west half.

MR. PORTER: How much does that leave out of the west half?

That's the limitation of the entire east half of the west half and northwest quarter.

In paragraph "P", I would recommend the Weir-Blinebry Pool be extended as shown on the Exhibit B of this case and the extension would be as follows: The west half, southeast quarter of Section 10, southwest quarter of Section 15, the northwest quarter of Section 22, all in Township 20 South, Range 37 East.

In paragraph "Q", I would recommend that the Indian Hills-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool be abolished and the acreage presently contained in that pool be included over in the extension which follows.

Paragraph "R", I'd recommend the Indian-Basin Upper Pennsylvanian Gas Pool be extended as shown on the docket and exhibit which is considerable acreage I won't describe.

Paragraph "S", I would recommend the Indian Basin-Morrow Pool be extended as on the docket and exhibit.

- Do you have anything further?
- No, sir,



Was the exhibit prepared under your supervision Q in your official capacity as Chief Engineer of the Oil Conservation Commission?

Yes, sir.

MR. DURRETT: I move the introduction of Exhibit "A" and that will conclude my examination of Mr. Nutter.

MR. PORTER: Would you have any objections to the exhibit being admitted, Mr. Nutter?

The purpose of abolishment of the Indian-Basin Upper Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, I assume, is that it has now been shown that the Indian-Basin Upper Pennsylvanian Gas Pool and the Indian Hills Upper Pennsylvanian Gas Pool were common reservoirs?

In all probability, it's probably common sand. MR. PORTER: Any questions of the witness? You may be excused.

Anything further to be offered in this case? The Commission will take the case under advisement and the Hearing will adjourn.

(Whereupon, the Hearing was adjourned at 9:50 o'clock A. M.)

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on June 11, 1964, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this <u>day</u> of June, 1964, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and subject matter thereof.
- That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Middle Pennsylvanian formation, said pool to bear the designation of North Bagley-Middle Pennsylvanian Pool. Said North Bagley-Middle Pennsylvanian Pool was discovered by Texas Pacific Oil Company, J. P. Collier No. 1, located in the May Unit F of Section 10, Township 11 South, Range 33 East, NMPM. It was completed in Middle Pennsylvanian on May 16, 1964. The top of perforations is 9862 feet. The special vertical limits are top of pool at -5397 feet subsea and bottom of pool at -5727 feet subsea. Type Log: Texas Pacific Oil Company, J. P.
