The location of the proposed treating plant is one mile west and one mile south of Eunice, New Mexico.

The type of the proposed treating plant is a gas fired coil upright heater, Viking pump circulated.

3.

The capacity for the proposed treating plant is 1500 barrels per day maximum.

That attached hereto and asked to be considered herein as a part of this application is a performance bond in the amount of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) with good and sufficient surety, conditioned upon substantial compliance with applicable statutes of the State of New Mexico and all rules, regulations and orders of the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico.
