called as a witness, having been first duly sworn on oath, was examined and testified as follows:

BY MR. DURRETT:

Will you please state your name and position for the Q record?

Joe D. Ramey, supervisor, District 1, New Mexico A Oil Conservation Commission.

Mr. Ramey, are you prepared to make recommendations Q to the Commission today concerning the issuance of a nomenclature order creating and extending certain pools in Lea and Roosevelt Counties, New Mexico?

- ves, sir.
- Have you prepared your recommendations in the form of Q an exhibit?
 - Yes, I have.
 - How is that marked?
 - Southeast Nomenclature Exhibit 1, Paragraphs (a)



through (h).

Q Will you please refer, Mr. Ramey, to Exhibit 1 and summarize that exhibit for the Commission, particularly pointing out any manner that that exhibit may be different from the docket that has been prepared and distributed here today?

A Yes, sir. It is similar to the docket with the exception of paragraph (b) which should be dismissed because of an error in advertising; paragraph (d), we have an addition to what is advertised of Section 21, Northeast Quarter. It's in Township 10 South, Range 36 East.

MR. PORTER: That is in paragraph (d)?

A (d). In paragraph (h) there's three additions, Section 29, the Southwest Quarter; Section 31, the Northeast Quarter; Section 32, the Northwest Quarter, all in Township 8 South, Range 33 East. Otherwise it is similar to what was advertised.

- Q (By Mr. Durrett) With the exceptions that you have pointed out to the Commission, the exhibit is identical to the docket that has been distributed here this morning?

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on July 15, 1964, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 17th day of July, 1964, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:





THE APPLICATION OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION UPON ITS OWN MOTION FOR AN ORDER CREATING AND EXTENDING CERTAIN POOLS IN CHAVES AND LEA COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO.

### ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

### BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on July 15, 1964, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this <u>day</u> of July, 1964, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

### FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and subject matter thereof.
- (2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Wolfcamp formation, said pool to bear the designation of Austin-Wolfcamp Pool. Said Austin-Wolfcamp Pool was discovered by Cabot Corporation, Austin State No. 1, located in the 1872, Unit F of Section 19, Township 14 South, Range 36 East, NMPM. It was completed in Lower Wolfcamp on March 19, 1964. The top of perforations is 10,357 feet.

(3) That the proposed creation of a new pool in Section 3,
Township 18 South, Range 35 Fast, Lea County, New Mexico,
for the production of oil from the Wolfcamp formation
Should be dismissed pending further study.

- (4) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of gas from the Pennsylvanian formation, said pool to bear the designation of Wilson-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool. Said Wilson-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool was discovered by The Pure Oil Company, Wilson Deep Unit No. 1, located in the way. Unit F of Section 13, Township 21 South, Range 34 East, NMPM. It was completed in Morrow on July 25, 1963. The top of perforations is 12,320 feet.
- (5) That there is need for certain extensions to the Tobac-Pennsylvanian Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, the South Crossroads-Devonian Pool, the Kemnitz-Wolfcamp Pool, the Mesa-Queen Pool, and the East Saunders-Permo Pennsylvanian Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico.

# IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Lower Wolfcamp production, is hereby created and designated as the Austin-Wolfcamp Pool, consisting of the following described area:

# TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM SECTION 19: NW/4

(b) That a new pool in Low County, New Mexico, elassified as an oil

That the proposed creation of a new pool in Lea County,

New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Wolfcamp production,

designated as the East Vacuum - Wolfcamp Pool, consisting of

the following described area:

pool for Wolfcamp production, is hereby ereated and designated as the Erst Vacuum Wolfcamp Pool, consisting of the following described area:

# TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 35 EAST, NMPM SECTION 3: SW/4 is hereby dismissed.

(c) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as a gas pool for Pennsylvanian production, is hereby created and designated as the Wilson-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, consisting of the following described area:

# TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 34 EAST, NMPM SECTION 13: NW/4

(d) That the South Crossroads-Devonian Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

# TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM SECTION 16: S/2 SECTION 21: NE/4

(e) That the Kemnitz-Wolfcamp Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as here-tofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

# TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 34 EAST, NMPM SECTION 22: SW/4

(f) That the Mesa-Queen Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

# TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 32 EAST, NAPM SECTION 7: N/2 and SE/4 SECTION 18: NE/4

(g) That the East Saunders-Permo Pennsylvanian Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

# TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 34 EAST, NMPM SECTION 20: SW/4

(h) That the Tobac-Pennsylvanian Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

# TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, NMPM SECTION 29: W/2 SECTION 31: NE/4 SECTION 32: NW/4

## IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That the effective date of this order and all creations and extensions included herein shall be August 1, 1964.
