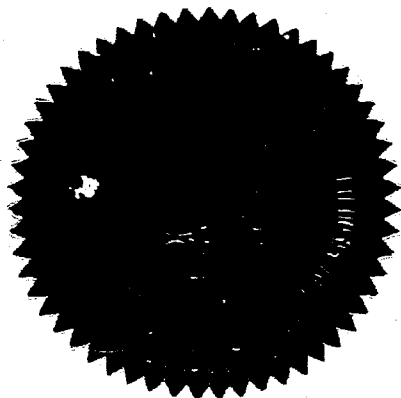

A The exhibit recommends extensions to existing pools. It differs from the docket in paragraph (f) by the addition of Section 8, Township 24 North, Range 6 West; East Half of the Northwest Quarter and the Northeast Quarter of that Section 8.

A Yes, sir.
