1. By Order No. R-2827 entered in Case No. 3159 on December 7, 1964, the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission created the Red Hills-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool with vertical limits comprising the Pennsylvanian formation and with horizontal limits as follows:

Township 25 South, Range 33 East Lea County, New Mexico Section 31: All Section 32: All Section 33: All Township 26 South, Range 33 East Lea County, New Mexico

Section 4: All Section 5: All Section 6: All

2. Hearing upon special rules and regulations for said pool was continued from the original examiner hearing on November 24, 1964 to an examiner hearing on January 6, 1965 and from that hearing to the regular Commission hearing on January 13, 1965 and from then to the regular Commission hearing on February 17, 1965. At the hearing on February 17, 1965, The Pure Oil Company intends to present evidence in support of its original

application for the establishment of temporary special rules and regulations for the Red Hills-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool notwith-standing the application in this case to subdivide the Pennsylvanian formation into three separate pools.

3. In the event the Commission should look favorably upon the application in this case and create three separate gas pools within the Pennsylvanian formation, temporary special rules and regulations for each of said pools should be established providing for 640-acre spacing units and well location requirements in conformity with the special rules and regulations established for the Red Hills-Wolf Camp and Red Hills-Devonian Gas Pools.

WHEREFORE, The Pure Oil Company requests consideration of special rules and regulations for the Red-Hills-Atoka, Strawn and Morrow Gas Pools, including provisions for 640-acre spacing and well location requirements, be included within the notice to be given in this case; and that in the event the Commission should create three separate gas pools within the Pennsylvanian formation as requested by the application herein, special rules and regulations for each pool be established as requested herein.

WHEREFORE, Applicants request the Commission to set this matter down for hearing before one of its examiners, to publish notice as required by law and, after hearing, issue its order creating and designating new gas pools as prayed for herein, and to provide for the orderly development of the common sources of supply in accordance with present existing rules and regulations.
