Gentlemen:

Tidewater respectfully submits this application for authority to inject produced salt water into the Justis Ellenburger formation for the purpose of disposal. The disposal well will be our A. B. Coates "C" No. 15, Unit O, Sec. 24, T25S, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico. Injection will be made into an interval below the present field water-oil contact. This well produced 228,258 barrels of Ellenburger oil from January 4, 1958 until November of 1965 at which time, producing from perforations 8000-8025' at the top of the formation, the well went to 100% salt water.

We propose to clean out Well No. 15 from the present plug-back TD (8027') to the original TD (8125'), then deepen the well to 8350'. A 4-1/2" casing liner will be set at 8350' with the liner hanger at 7950'. Cement volumes will be calculated to circulate back over the liner hanger. The liner will be perforated at 8325 to 8345'. The original field water-oil contact was established at 8335'.

The waters to be injected are from wells on our A. B. Coates "C" and "D" Leases producing out of the Justis Blinebry, Justis Tubb-Drinkard, Justis Montoya, Justis McKee, Justis Fusselman and Justis Ellenburger zones. Production from these zones is gathered at a consolidated battery. Water production is presently dumped from the various zone facilities into earthen pits. Total water production is currently averaging 450 barrels per day.

We plan to set a 500 barrel settling tank which will collect salt water from all water dumps. A pump will then transfer the salt water through 3" cement lined pipe to the injection well.

Well No. 15 is a Justis Montoya-Justis Ellenburger dual completion

with parallel strings of 2-3/8 tubing inside of 7" casing. When this well is with parallel strings of 2-3/0 tubing inside of (casing, when this well is converted to salt water disposal, the Ellenburger tubing string (lower zone tubing string) will have internal plastic coating for corrosion protection. The two zones will be segregated with a packer.

A plat showing the location of the proposed injection well, together with logs and a diagrammatic sketch are attached. A copy of this application with all attachments has been sent to the New Mexico State Engineering Office.

We respectfully request that this application be scheduled for Examiner hearing on January 5, 1966, in Santa Fe. Very truly yours,


