ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 3 a.m. on April 19, 1967, at Hobbs, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 24th day of April, 1967, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That there is need for certain extensions to the South Hospah Lower Sand Oil Pool in McKinley County, New Mexico, the Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool, both in Rio Arriba, Sandoval and San Juan Counties, New Mexico, and the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool, the Many Rocks-Gallup Oil Pool, and the Piñon-Gallup Oil Pool, all in San Juan County, New Mexico.
