ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on April 17, 1968, at Hobbs, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 25th day of April, 1968, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That there is need for certain extensions to the Antec-Pictured Cliffs Pool, the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool, the Slick Rock-Dakota Oil Pool, and the Tooto Dome-Pennsylvanian "D" Oil Pool, all in San Juan County, New Mexico, the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool, the Otero-Chacara Pool, and the Tapacito-Gallup Associated Pool, all in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, the South Hospah-Lower Sand Oil Pool and the South Hospah-Upper Sand Oil Pool, both in McKinley County, New Mexico, the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool in Rio Arriba, Sandoval, and San Juan Counties, New Mexico, and the Blanco-Masaverde Pool in Rio Arriba and San Juan Counties, New Mexico.



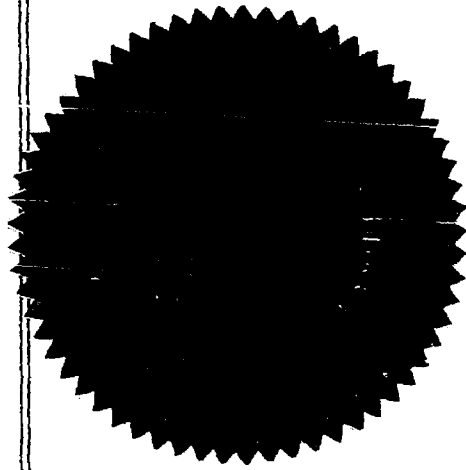
