Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks authority to dispose of water produced in the South Vacuum-Devonian Pool into the Devonian formation in the interval from 12,000 feet to 12,180 feet in its John Trigg Lea Federal J Well No. 2 located in Unit P of Section 14, Township 18 South, Range 35 East, Reeves-Devonian Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.
