The New Mexico Energy, Minerals and Natural Resource Department's Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has received Basin Disposal Inc.'s (BDI) letter, dated December 14, 2022, responding to OCD's notice directing BDI to proceed with the Closure and Site Reclamation of the 3RF-2, Basin Water Recycling Facility pursuant to 19.15.34.14 NMAC.

After reviewing BDI's response, OCD identified an inaccuracy in its original letter. Specifically, OCD stated that BDI had not requested an extension for the cessation of operations since April 22, 2020. After rereviewing our record, OCD confirmed that BDI had in fact requested an extension for the cessation of operations in conjunction with an annual extension of the registration/permit on June 9, 2022. OCD granted the annual extension request for the registration/permit on June 30, 2022, but did not officially act on the cessation of operations request. Given that OCD did not specifically approve or reject the extension request for the cessation of operations, OCD will honor BDI's extension requested for the cessation of operations for the time period from June 30, 2022 through December 31, 2022, which would have been the duration of the original request.

As part of the OCD's annual extension approval the following condition of approval was included:

If less than 20% of the total fluid capacity is utilized every consecutive six months, operation of the facility is considered ceased and notification of cessation of operations should be sent electronically to OCD's E-Permitting Portal. An extension to extend the cessation of operations, not to exceed six months, may be submitted using a C-147 form to OCD Online.

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In order to evaluate the current status of the facility, OCD is requesting C-148 Forms to demonstrate the total amount of fluid capacity utilized along with weekly inspection records of the containment and leak detection system during the six-month time period from July 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022. OCD is requesting this information no later than February 15, 2023 (i.e., 3-weeks from email receipt).
