ORDER GRANTING GRIFFIN'S MOTION TO DISMISS WITH PREJUDICE

This matter comes before the Division on Griffin Energy Law, PLCC's (Griffin) *Unopposed Motion to Dismiss [Case No. 23779] with Prejudice* filed on October 6, 2023. Having considered the pleading and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, I FIND:

1. Mewbourne Oil Company (Mewbourne) filed Case No. 21496 on October 5, 2020, a hearing was conducted on November 5, 2020, and Order No. R-21537 was issued on November 13, 2020.
2. Subsequently, Mewbourne discovered a previously unidentified interest owner in the unit and filed Case No. 21960, which was heard on June 17, 2021, and Order No. R-21537-A was issued on June 25, 2021.
3. On September 1, 2023, Griffin filed Applications to rescind Case Nos. 21496 and 21960.
4. Griffin and Mewbourne have since resolved their differences, and Griffin respectfully requests that Case No. 23779 be dismissed accordingly.
5. Mewbourne concurs with this request.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT Case No 23779 is dismissed with prejudice.
