NUNC PRO TUNC ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

It appearing to the Commission that Order No. R-2156-A,
dated August 22, 1972, does not correctly state the intended
order of the Commission:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That Paragraph (1) on Page 2 of Order No. R-2156-A
is hereby corrected to read in its entirety as follows:

"(1) That the applicant, Murphy H. Baxter, is hereby
authorized to drill a well at an unorthodox location 1295 feet
from the South line and 1411 feet from the West line of Sec-
tion 18, Township 17 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Maljamar
(Grayburg-San Andres) Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, as a pro-
ducing well in its Maljamar (Grayburg-San Andres) Unit Waterflood
Project."

(2) That this order shall be effective nunc pro tunc as
of August 22, 1972.
