ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a. m. on November 18, 1964, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 20th day of November, 1964, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and subject matter thereof.

(2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Strawn formation, said pool to bear the designation of West Bagley-Pennsylvanian Pool. Said West Bagley-Pennsylvanian Pool was discovered by Sunray DX Oil Company, New Mexico State "AS" No. 1, located in Unit G of Section 29, Township 11 South, Range 33 East, NMPM. It was completed in Strawn on August 4, 1964. The top of perforations is 10,007 feet.

(3) That there is need for certain extensions to the Tobac-Pennsylvanian Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, the Milnesand-San Andres Pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, the Lovington-Paddock Pool and the Lusk-Strawn Pool, both in Lea County, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Strawn production, is hereby created and designated as the West Bagley-Pennsylvanian Pool, consisting of the following described area:

SECTION 29: NE/4

(b) That the Lovington-Paddock Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM  
SECTION 33: NE/4

(c) That the Lusk-Strawn Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 32 EAST, NMPM  
SECTION 5: SW/4  
SECTION 6: NE/4  
SECTION 32: SW/4

(d) That the Milnesand-San Andres Pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 34 EAST, NMPM  
SECTION 25: SE/4

TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 35 EAST, NMPM  
SECTION 29: W/2  
SECTION 30: SE/4  
SECTION 31: NW/4

(e) That the Tobac-Pennsylvanian Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, NMPM  
SECTION 20: SW/4, S/2 NW/4, and N/2 NE/4  
SECTION 29: SE/4

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That the effective date of this order and all creations and extensions included herein shall be December 1, 1964.
