WELL NO. 1 LOCATED 660 FEET FROM THE NORTH LINE AND 1380 FEET FROM THE WEST LINE, AND SARGENT WELL NO. 1 LOCATED 1445 FEET FROM THE SOUTH LINE AND 925 FEET FROM THE WEST LINE.


