ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on June 5, 1974, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Daniel S. Nutter.

NOW, on this <u>llth</u> day of June, 1974, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Read & Stevens, seeks an order extending the horizontal limits of the Cemetary-Morrow Gas Pool to include therein all of Sections 20, 29, and 30, Township 20 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.
- (3) That the geologic data available establishes that the Morrow formation underlying said Sections 20, 29, and 30 is part of the same Morrow structure underlying the Cemetary-Morrow Gas Pool and is in communication therewith.
- (4) That in order to prevent waste and protect correlative rights, the horizontal boundaries of the Cemetary-Morrow Gas Pool should be extended to include therein said Sections 20, 29, and 30.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the horizontal boundaries of the Cemetary-Morrow Gas Pool are hereby extended to include in said pool the following described area:
