ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on June 5, 1974,  
at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Daniel S. Nutter.

NOW, on this 11th day of June, 1974, the Commission,  
a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the  
record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being  
fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required  
by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the  
subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Read & Stevens, seeks an order  
extending the horizontal limits of the Cemetary-Morrow Gas Pool  
to include therein all of Sections 20, 29, and 30, Township 20  
South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

(3) That the geologic data available establishes that the  
Morrow formation underlying said Sections 20, 29, and 30 is part  
of the same Morrow structure underlying the Cemetary-Morrow  
Gas Pool and is in communication therewith.

(4) That in order to prevent waste and protect correlative  
rights, the horizontal boundaries of the Cemetary-Morrow Gas  
Pool should be extended to include therein said Sections 20,  
29, and 30.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the horizontal boundaries of the Cemetary-Morrow  
Gas Pool are hereby extended to include in said pool the follow-  
ing described area:




(2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
